

THE HOST SCHOOL WILL PROVIDE FLAGS FOR ALL LINE JUDGES. It is the host schools responsibility to secure, instruct and train line judges (preferably adults). The use of flags by line judges are required for all varsity matches and strongly recommended at all levels. Should flags not be available for a varsity match, the match will be played using hand signals and the officials will notify the KSHSAA once the event has concluded.

The flags should be solid red in color and of a recommended size of approximately 12 inches by 12 inches to approximately 16 inches by 16 inches. The flag and hand grip should be securely affixed to the pole.

- 1. **INBOUNDS** Point the flag down and toward the middle of the court
- 2. **OUT-OF-BOUNDS** Raise the flag, arm extended.
- 3. **TOUCH** Raise the flag to shoulder height in front of body and place the open palm of the other hand on top of the flag.
- 4. **ANTENNA VIOLATION** Wave the flag over the head and point to the antenna. **FOOT FAULT** Wave the flag over the head and point to the service area using index finger, extended arm shoulder height.
- **5. VIEW OF PLAY BLOCKED** Raise and cross both arms in front of the chest, palms facing the body.
