Executive Board Meeting KSHSAA Board Room Wednesday, November 17, 2021

CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

The following items were all approved unanimously via consent:

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board heard reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reviewed fall activities which have been completed and gave a preview of winter activities where possible. The Executive Director gave a financial report and provided an overview of the annual report to the Kansas State Board of Education.

POSTSEASON SCHEDULE UPDATES APPROVED

Assistant Executive Director Mark Lentz discussed two postseason schedules with Board members and asked for their approval moving forward.

- Wrestling Regional tournaments approved for one-day tournaments provided numbers dictate. Wrestlers at these tournaments would be approved to wrestle a potential 6th match in one day as permitted by NFHS rules.
- Track & Field State championship meet schedule for 2022 approved.

2021 FALL ADMINISTRATOR AND BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS

The Executive Director reported 60 middle/junior and 195 senior high schools were represented by 290 people who attended the seven KSHSAA Regional Administrator and Board of Education Meetings. The attendance figures were as follows:

Discussion Topics, Voting Results and Executive Board Actions

(NOTE: Detailed votes by Classes and Middle/Junior High Schools are available upon request)

1. **(Basketball - Classes 6A, 5A, 4A - Girls and Boys)** Should KSHSAA change their tie-breaking procedure for post-season basketball to reflect a point differential per game (maxing out at 15 p.p.g.) as opposed to the current model which only relies on defensive points allowed?

YES 86 NO 1

- **EB Action:** Staff recommended a modified version of the proposal which utilizes an average point differential per game for all classes. Following discussion, the Board voted to implement the modified proposal in all classes beginning in the 2022-23 school year.
- 2. **(Basketball Girls and Boys)** Should the KSHSAA adopt a shot clock per NFHS rule amendment beginning with the 2022-23 school year?

- **EB Action:** Following a review of regional meeting votes and further discussion by members, the Board voted to not adopt the shot clock for Kansas schools at this time.
- 3. **(Golf-Girls and Boys)** Should the KSHSAA allow student athletes that participate in golf to participate in one outside golf competition, approved by KSHSAA, during the school season?

- **EB Action:** The Board directed staff to develop specific handbook language which would reflect modifications to allow for a one-time in-season opportunity for events identified by the KSHSAA working in conjunction with the USGA and the AJGA. The specific language will be reviewed at the January meeting for placement on the April Board of Directors meeting agenda.
- 4. **(General)** Should the KSHSAA allow students participating in any quasi-team activity the opportunity to participate in one outside competition, approved by the KSHSAA, in the same activity during the time they are on the school team in that activity?

- **EB Action:** This item was tabled until the handbook language for outside competition in golf has been considered and determined.
- 5. **(General)** Should the KSHSAA utilize a classification multiplier as developed by the 2021 KSHSAA Public/Private Work Group?

YES 106 NO 84

EB Action: The Executive Board reviewed information provided on the private school classification multiplier following regional meeting discussions. It was recommended the proposal suggested by the Public/Private Classification Work Group be modified to apply the three components only to private schools that have won five or more state team championships in the most recent five school years.

Following discussion, the Executive Board tabled this item until their January 2022 meeting. Staff was asked to create handbook language for using the multiplier with the championship factor serving as a trigger for all components of possible multiplier adoption.

FALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

At the time of the meeting, seven of ten fall championships had been completed thanks to the hard work of the host sites, support staff, and administrative leaders for each activity. KSHSAA staff provided the Board members with a review and learning from each activity. Discussion focused on changes for future fall postseason events.

NFHS NETWORK

NFHS Network administrator Mark Koski joined the Executive Board (via Zoom online video conference) to provide an update on NFHS Network items. Discussion included financial stability of the Network and revenue generated by KSHSAA member schools, school broadcast partners, and efforts to enhance the Network quality and experience for stakeholders.

ELIGIBILITY REVIEW

Following a transfer of a student back to his original school after attending a basketball academy in another state, a request was made by the member school for the Executive Board to provide eligibility options for this student pursuant to **Rule 18, Transfer, Section 10.** Following a review of information regarding this transfer, the Board determined Section 10 is not intended for students returning home from a sports focused academy or school. In this case, the student could apply for eligibility based on a transfer from a non-member school per **Rule 18-1-4** provided he meets all other eligibility requirements. In addition, any games or scrimmages the student played at the non-member school during the current school year would count towards his 20 games played and because of his practice time at the previous school, the student may not start practice with his current team until January 1st. The Board then directed staff for updated language on **Transfer Rule 18-1-10** to be brought before the Board of Directors at their April 2022 meeting for approval.

GAMEDAY SHOWCASE

A report was given on final preparations for the Gameday Showcase which will be conducted on Friday, November 19 (Dance) and Saturday, November 20 (Cheer) at the Topeka Stormont Vail Events Center. Information on the schools participating were discussed as well as information on the format for the first in-person Dance Showcase.

US COUNCIL FOR ATHLETES' HEALTH

Staff met with members of the US Council for Athletes Health and reviewed with the Board information offered by the USCAH and how it might be used in Kansas. Staff also shared this information with the KSHSAA SMAC to ensure congruency of mission without duplication of efforts. One topic discussed with both groups was coaching education and how the USCAH can enhance Kansas efforts to provide education to coaches and sponsors.

ARBITER/GOFAN PARTNERSHIP

Recently two partners of the KSHSAA have teamed up to create a school management program to support efficiency in scheduling and communicating with stakeholders. Arbiter and GoFan have now offered all KSHSAA member schools free access to *ArbiterGame*. Staff provided information to the Board on this new opportunity. Member schools who choose to participate would be able to have more control over their accounts instead of needing a program administrator or league commissioner to make changes for officials' assignments. ArbiterGame will also allow for syncing between the KSHSAA, Arbiter and GoFan accounts to streamline the amount of information schools need to input online. KSHSAA staff will roll out ArbiterGame implementation with schools so as to allow for smooth transitions from other accounts that may have similar functions if schools choose to use this free program.

OPEN GYM POLICY

As part of their September 15-16, 2020, meeting, the Executive Board approved a "gender specific" open gym policy for the 2020-21 school year, based upon an effort to reduce the number of participants at any one time in a school gym due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Executive Board reviewed this policy after the first year of application and considered a permanent interpretation of an acceptable open gym policy. Following discussion of the open gym definition and handbook rules aligned with supervision policies, the Board determined to no longer allow gender specific open gyms. Accordingly, schools should revert to its original policy for open gyms which provides an opportunity for all students in the school to participate in an open gym in order to comply with **Seasons of Activities, Rule 30.**

SPORTSMANSHIP

Staff provided data relative to ejections/exclusions which occurred during the 2021 fall season. Feedback was given to the Board relative to a sportsmanship summit recently held by the Central Plains League and ideas generated by students who participated.

Additionally, the Board approved a modification to the newly adopted exclusion policy for inappropriate behavior at KSHSAA events as follows:

Any participant (player, coach, spectator) who is ejected for making contact with an official, who is ejected for unsporting behavior directed toward an official, or who negatively confronts an official following a contest, shall be subject to a non-appealable suspension from the next contest at that level and for all contests at any level (in that activity) until the suspension has been served. Local school leadership may levy additional sanctions as they deem appropriate.

The KSHSAA staff reviews all ejection reports.

Note: the requirement for all ejected students to complete the NFHS Sportsmanship course and the requirement for all ejected coaches to complete the NFHS Teaching and Modeling Behavior course prior to being reinstated remain in effect.

BASEBALL & SOFTBALL MANUAL UPDATES

Staff requested the Board consider updates for the baseball and softball manuals relative to game times, game order, and other operational items which may affect postseason brackets. The following was approved:

- 1. The home team has right to play the second game in a three-game series, without regard to combined mileage of participating schools.
- 2. The initial game time for a series of games will be posted, and all subsequent games at that site will follow per designated time period. This will allow for a "rolling schedule" with subsequent games beginning approximately 25 minutes following the conclusion of the previous game.

NAME IMAGE AND LIKENESS

Based upon recent developments with the NCAA regarding student opportunities relative to "Name, Image and Likeness" the Board members continued discussion regarding this concept at the interscholastic level and how KSHSAA Handbook **Rule 21****Amateur* pertains. The Board supported adoption of the following interpretations of this rule and new NCAA rules pertaining to NIL as an extension of Rule 21:

- A student may be compensated as an influencer or representative and/or provide an endorsement pending the following:
- There shall be no interruption of the school day for the student;
- There shall be no reference to school name, school team, school logo, nor school mascot;
- · Member school uniform may not be used by the student in any endorsement;
- · Member school facilities may not be used in any student endorsement;
- · Member school awards or awards won by students participating in activities shall not be referenced;
- No school practice film nor game film may be used in promotional activities;
- Neither endorsements nor promotions may be used to influence attendance at a member school;
- Students are not permitted to promote or endorse activities associated with the following: tobacco, alcohol, banned athletic substances, illegal substances or activities, or wagering.

While member schools may have additional local policies as it pertains to their name, image, and/or likeness, the interpretations will continue to evolve.

KSHSAA TRUEBLUE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM UPDATE

An updated draft of the KSHSAA Covered TrueBlue Scholarship program was provided to Board members. The program comes from the partnership between the KSHSAA and Capitol Federal and is a featured component of KSHSAA Covered. Over the last few months, Assistant Executive Director Jeremy Holaday has worked with counterparts from CapFed to create an applicant criteria list and awarding timeline for the scholarship. Feedback from Board members was provided on application retrieval methods, the number of categories an applicant may choose and a time limit for use of awarded funds. While CapFed and KSHSAA staff have worked on the criteria, Board members were asked to provide names of individuals who could possibly serve on committees to choose the scholarship winners.
