Motion by Kastle, second by Thon to waive the required written notice for any meeting of the Executive Board as specified in **KSHSAA Bylaw Article V, Section 7**. Motion passed 12-0.

## **UNIFIED BOWLING ACTIVITY STATUS CHANGE**

A request was made to provide a review and consider modification regarding the status of Unified Bowling compared to interscholastic bowling. Specifically, per previous discussion at the Board's regularly scheduled September meeting, the Kansas Bowling Proprietors Association asked the KSHSAA to consider Unified Bowling as a different activity than interscholastic bowling. In a recent meeting, representatives of the KBPA, KSHSAA administrators, and school/district administrators reviewed differences between the two activities. Following discussion, a motion was made by Romstad, seconded by Thon, to define Unified Bowling as a different activity from interscholastic bowling so students can participate in competitions (leagues and tournaments) while on the school Unified Bowling team without violating **Rule 22, Outside Competition**. The motion passed 11-1.

There being no other business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 8:36 a.m.
