The Executive Board met in the office of the Kansas State High School Activities Association on Tuesday and Wednesday, September 15-16, 2020, with the following in attendance: President Alan Stein, Shannon Haydock, Jason Herman, Deena Horst, Mike Kastle, Monty Marlin, Roger Perkins, Greg Rosenhagen, Ken Stonebraker, and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. ## ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board received financial and administrative reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick, Assistant Executive Directors Cheryl Gleason, Francine Martin, Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Craig Manteuffel, Rod Garman and Office/Operations Manager Brent Unruh.

## 2019-20 AUDIT REPORT APPROVED

Mr. Faflick presented the Executive Board with the annual certified audit report prepared by Wendling, Noe, Nelson, & Johnson L.L.C. of Topeka. Eric Otting, CPA, represented the accounting firm by providing a review of the audit and the Board voted unanimously to approve the audit report. The report will be printed in the next issue of the *KSHSAA Activities Journal*.

## **STUDENT HEALTH AND SAFETY**

The Executive Board confirmed the commitment to providing risk mitigation strategies and appropriate support for students, coaches, and school communities. Members engaged in discussion regarding the escalating concern regarding the mental health of a student who tests positive for COVID-19 and subsequent impact of possible quarantine. ### 2020-21 BUDGET APPROVED

Following a hearing held on Wednesday, September 16, 2020 at 11:30 a.m., in the office of the KSHSAA, the Executive Board unanimously approved the KSHSAA budget for the 2020-21 school year and authorized its publication and distribution to the member schools.

## **CROSS COUNTRY POSTSEASON MODIFICATIONS APPROVED**

Proposed cross country postseason format modifications were presented, discussed, and approved. It is recommended the proposed protocols be approved for implementation for the fall regional and state meets for fall 2020. Modifications included limiting roster to participating athletes only (7 per qualifying team), reducing number of individual qualifiers, and limiting spectator admission to 4 guests per participant.

## **VOLLEYBALL POSTSEASON MODIFCATIONS APPROVED**

Proposed volleyball postseason tournament format was presented, discussed, and approved. The Executive Board adopted geographic pods for sub-state with state quarterfinals to be played at the site of the even numbered paired pod on Tuesday of state championship week, qualifying only four teams per class to the state championship site for a one day tournament.

## SOCCER POSTSEASON MODIFICATIONS APPROVED

The proposed soccer postseason tournament format was presented, discussed, and approved. The Executive Board adopted (for fall 2020 season) geographic pods for regional and quarterfinals with games to be played at higher seed prior to the state semifinals. Semifinal game times of 4:00 PM and 7:00 PM were approved along with Consolation match at Noon and Championship Match at 3:00 PM.

Additionally, the board waived (for this season) the seeding criteria for postseason which indicated any team that did not play 10 games resulted in a seeding percentage to be halved.

## GIRLS GOLF POSTSEASON MODIFICATIONS APPROVED

The proposed golf postseason tournament format was presented, discussed, and approved. The Executive Board adopted the following modification for the 2020 Girls Golf season:

- Regionals: Maximum entries per school were reduced to 5 from 6
- State: The top three teams from each regional will qualify, reduced from four.
- Five individuals per qualifying team will participate.
- No changes to individual qualifiers not on a qualifying team.
- Day Two: No reduction of entries/qualifiers for day two.

## GIRLS TENNIS POSTSEASON MODIFICATIONS APPROVED

The proposed tennis postseason tournament format was presented, discussed, and approved. The Executive Board adopted a reduced number of singles and doubles competitors for state tourneys for this year (for this year, the top four regional placers will advance as opposed to traditional top six finishers)

## SCHOLARS BOWL POSTSEASON MODIFICATIONS REVIEWED

The proposed virtual Scholars Bowl competition format and procedures were introduced, discussed, and recommended for adoption in the event in-person competition is not possible. The online competition format and procedures were developed in consultation with the Kansas Association of Scholars Bowl Coaches (KASBC). The online format and procedures will only be used if in-person competition is not possible due to COVID-19 restrictions. Determination for in-person versus online postseason competition will be declared after the November 18-19, 2020 KSHSAA Executive Board Meetings.

If postseason competition (regional and state) is online, the following modifications were approved:

- Add another Regional date of Monday, February 1 for 1A, 3A, and 5A competitions and designate the existing Regional date of Thursday, February 4 for 2A, 4A, and 6A competitions. This is needed due to the online format necessitating the need for more moderators and judges since each participating school will have one.
- Add a new due date for Regional Entry Forms from 1A, 3A, and 5A schools which will be Tuesday, January 26. The Regional Entry Form due date for 2A, 4A, and 6A schools will still be Friday, January 29, as stated in the Scholars Bowl Manual and published in the KSHSAA Calendar.

## **MODIFICATION OF GIRLS GOLF RULE 36-2-7**

At their meeting on August 28, 2020, the Board of Director extended the authority of the Executive Board to alter competition limitations; accordingly, the following modification was approved:

#### **Section 2: Senior High Regulations**

- **Art. 7:** No student representing a member school shall participate in more than eight days of interschool competition during a season, exclusive of regional and state tournaments.
  - a. Two dual matches, either nine or 18 holes, may be substituted for one day of the allowed eight days of competition provided no loss of instruction time would take place for competition and/or travel.
  - b. Schools are encouraged to schedule as many quadrangular or smaller events as possible. It is recommended these events start after school hours.
  - c. On those days when schooltime is used, only two matches or tournaments may start prior to 3 p.m. C.T. and four additional matches or tournaments may start no earlier than 1 p.m. C.T. The two remaining matches must begin no earlier than 3 p.m. C.T.
  - d. Due to COVID-19, if schools are unable to find course time because of rescheduling additional smaller meets, schools may have an additional two meets that begin after 1:00 p.m. The maximum of eight competitions remain.

## **MODIFICATION OF CROSS COUNTRY RULE 34-2-2**

At their meeting on August 28, 2020, the Board of Director extended the authority of the Executive Board to alter competition limitations; accordingly, the following modification was approved:

#### **Section 2: Senior High Regulations**

- **Art. 2:** No student representing a member school shall participate in more than seven meets during a season, exclusive of regional and state meets.
  - a. Schools are encouraged to schedule as many quadrangular or smaller meets as possible. It is recommended these meets start after school hours.
  - b. On those days when school time is used, only two competitions may start prior to 3:00 p.m. C.T.
  - c. Due to COVID-19, if host schools divide large meets into two smaller meets on the same day, schools may have an additional two meets that begin after 1:00 p.m.

## POSTSEASON DEBATE STRUCTURE MODIFIED

With input from staff working in collaboration with the Kansas Speech Communications Association, the Executive Board approved the virtual format for the 2020-2 postseason debate structure. This includes an updated tabulation process and a virtual state tournament to be extended to 2.5 days due to additional time required between rounds and to address screen time fatigue. A reduction in the number of tournaments required to participate in postseason was also approved.

## FOOTBALL POSTSEASON SEEDING CRITERIA AND GAME TIMES MODIFIED

The football postseason procedures were modified by implementation of seeding criteria being based upon average marginal points for postseason bracket development.

The Executive Board also approved modification of the 8-player championship game times of 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. with the extra time between games to empty the stadium and to complete appropriate cleaning and disinfection protocols.

## POSTSEASON ATTENDANCE PROTOCOLS APPROVED

The Executive Board received and discussed recommendations to limit attendance at all KSHSAA postseason events. It was approved that all events would be limited to 50% of the seating capacity or defer to local health authorities if more restrictive.

## GAME DAY SHOWCASE APPROVED FOR VIRTUAL FORMAT

The Executive Board discussed and approved the recommendation for a virtual Game Day Showcase format for the November 2020 cheer and dance events.

## **GYMNASTICS ITEM ADDED TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS AGENDA**

The Executive Board added the following staff recommendation to the previously printed September 16, 2020 Board of Directors Agenda:

Rule 37, Gymnastics, Section 2, Article 1 – With a delayed start for some gymnastics programs, it is recommended the KSHSAA would extend the season two additional weeks for this year only.

Art. 1: All school practice and competition shall be confined within the opening dates of practice and state championship meets on Standardized Calendar Week **#16** <u>#18</u> (change made for fall 2020 ONLY).

This modification would move the state meet to Saturday, November 7 (same day as State Soccer) from the current state date of October 24 (same day as Substate Volleyball and Regional Cross Country).

## **CROSS COUNTRY ITEM ADDED TO BOD AGENDA**

Based upon a recommendation by the Sports Medicine Advisory Committee at their September 9th meeting, the following items were approved for addition to the September 16, 2020 Board of Directors agenda:

#### Rule 34 - Cross Country

Art. 1: No member school shall participate in a meet until it has had (14) days of training.

Each athlete shall participate in 9 days of practice with the team prior to participating in a meet. (See Rule 30-1-8a-e, Seasons of Activities).

EXCEPTION: Students participating in the state basketball tournament may participate with fewer than 9 days of practice.

#### Rule 35 - Football

- **Art. 1:** No middle/junior or senior high school shall be represented in a game with any outside teams or group until it has had (JH/MS 13, HS 14) days of practice prior to (and not including) the first scheduled day of competition. Competition shall not begin prior to Wednesday of Standardized Calendar Week #9. No middle/junior high school shall be represented in a scrimmage with any outside teams. (See Rule 30-1-8a-e, Seasons of Activities).
  - a. Credit shall be given for a full day's practice whether or not it is on a school day.
  - b. Each individual player shall participate in at least nine days of practice before their first game.

#### Rule 38 - Soccer

Art. 2: No member school shall participate in a contest until it has had (9) nine days of team practice, prior to and not including the first scheduled day of competition. (See Rule 30-1-8a-e, Seasons of Activities).

a. Each athlete shall participate in (9) nine days of practice with the team prior to participating in a contest.

EXCEPTION: <u>Students</u> Girls participating in the state basketball tournament may participate with fewer than 9 days of practice.

Rationale: If schools choose to participate in the Alternative Fall, heat will not be an issue during the preseason (season begins 3/1). Additionally, the participants who were also participating on a state basketball tournament team will have a conditioning foundation established.

These exceptions would only be in place for the spring of 2021 for those schools participating in the alternative fall season.

## OCTOBER ADMINISTRATOR AND BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS

The October Administrator and Board of Education meetings will be held virtually this year and will take place using classification groupings instead of regional groupings as in years past. The dates for these meetings and the topics to be discussed are as follows:

#### **Meeting Topics**

- 1. **(Bowling)** Should the KSHSAA adopt Unified Sports Bowling as a fully endorsed KSHSAA sport, consistent with KSHSAA/NFHS rules regarding Unified sports?
  - a. What is the best season (fall, winter, spring) in which to hold competitions?
  - b. How many competitions should be held?
  - c. Squad composition (number of Athletes v Partners) regulations?
  - d. If any, what KSHSAA rules need to be waived/modified?
- 2. **(Football 8-Player)** Should the KSHSAA change the format of Districts to place teams into 1st round pools of four? The 1st round pool will still be seeded as a 1v4, 2v3 match up with the winners moving on to face each other in the 2nd round. There will be one team from each district making up these pools of four teams. The district assignments, district point system, and cross-district alignments would not be changed at all.
- 3. **(Football Classes 6A, 5A, 4A)** The Executive Board supported efforts to address the week 9 football revenue sharing by referring this issue to Regional Administrator meeting. The focus will be to address possible modification to the revenue sharing amounts between home and visiting schools (after payment of game officials). Should the KSHSAA modify the 50/50 revenue sharing model in place for week 9 football games in classes 6A, 5A and 4A?
- 4. Quasi-Team/Individual Activities Balancing team/individual entries for postseason.
  - a. What should be the primary consideration for regional assignments: Number of athletes or number of schools?
  - b. Other factors to consider?

7. **(Coaching Education)** Should the KSHSAA develop a series of coaching education courses to become required content for annual training?

#### 8. Mental Health

The vote tabulations and discussion highlights will be provided to the Executive Board at their November meeting at which time they will formulate next steps for each respective item.

## LIMITED EXPANSION OF OPEN GYM OPPORTUNITY

Following discussion on open gym and a review of current protocol, the Executive Board approved "gender specific" open gym opportunities for this school year. This designation allows for reduced numbers in the facility while maintain equal access to both genders. This decision will be evaluated at the end of the year in consideration of a extending this interpretation.

Following a hearing held on Wednesday, September 16, 2020 at 11:30 a.m. in the office of the KSHSAA, the Executive Board unanimously approved the KSHSAA budget for the 2020-21 school year and authorized its publication and distribution to member schools.

Assistant Executive Directors Cheryl Gleason, Francine Martin, Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Craig Manteuffel, Rod Garman and Office/Operations Manager Brent Unruh also participated.

## VIRTUAL COMPETITION APPROVED FOR DEBATE POSTSEASON

The Executive Board received an overview of the Virtual Postseason Debate Summary provided by staff. It was recommended by KSHSAA staff to move forward with virtual platforms for the 2020-21, 4-Speaker and 2-Speaker debate postseason tournaments. Following discussion, a motion was made to approve the proposal for virtual platform. The motion passed 9-0.

## CHAMPIONSHIP BRACKET PROTOCOL INTRODUCED

The Executive Board received the championship bracket protocol and following discussion, had no suggestions for change. Staff will follow this protocol for all students and/or teams designated for quarantine by local health authorities.

# WINTER MORATORIUM MODIFICATIONS DISCUSSED

Staff provided an overview of a consideration to extend the Handbook Rule 9 Moratoriums by potential alteration of the winter moratorium. Possible modifications included extending the no contact period between athletes and coaches from December 23-27 to proposed December 23-31. Another consideration would be to implement a competition moratorium for the first two weeks of January. In that scenario, school teams would be allowed to practice from January 1-14 and competition would begin no earlier than Friday, January 15. The Executive Board directed staff to include this item on the slate of topics for discussion and input during the Classification (Regional) Administrator and BOE meetings.
