## SEPTEMBER "TO DO"

**MEMBERSHIP DRIVE** – Conduct Club Membership Drive (see info below).

**DISCUSS CLUB GOAL FOR 2009-2010**  
Review requirements for Club Goal/Award. See KAY Handbook, Section 7.

**SEPTEMBER 15 RC MAILING** – All KAY Clubs will receive a large mailing on September 15. Please read carefully (see contents enclosed).

**CONDUCT A SERVICE PROJECT** – Don't wait too long to get started on your first service project. Have one with your membership drive to generate interest in joining KAY. And don't forget the Area Project activity.

**ALWAYS LOOK AHEAD!** – Plan & prepare.

## KAY MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

It is important to conduct your membership drive as soon as possible. Please consider:

**DATES/LENGTH OF DRIVE** – Set the time period for joining KAY. It is recommended that this time last no longer than 7-10 days and that it take place in late August/early September

**MEMBERSHIP DUES** – Joining KAY in your school should be affordable to all students. Don't forget that you will **send the KSHSAA \$2** for each member and retain the remainder for your club treasury. **PLEASE DO NOT** make your membership dues your club fund raiser!

**"OUR KAY CLUB"** – It is recommended that when members join KAY that you have them complete and turn-in "OUR KAY CLUB" form, located in Section 2 of KAY Handbook, page 5. Copy, change as needed & retain for year.

**WHAT IS KAY?** – Prepare a pamphlet, make signs, conduct an assembly, etc. to let students know what the KAY program is. Outline some of the projects you have planned. Build excitement!
