

## 2012-2013 Basketball Class 1A Divisions

### Rule 5-2-1 (Classification of Senior High Schools)

Class 1A schools shall compete in 2 separate divisions in volleyball, basketball and scholars bowl. Following the annual classification and determination of schools Class 1A the half of the schools with the larger enrollment will be assigned to Division I and the half with the smaller enrollment will be assigned to Division II. If there are an odd number of schools, Division I will be assigned more schools than Division II. **There is the possibility that a school's boys and girls teams could be split into different divisions because the number of schools participating varies.**

\*\*Art. 2 – If 2 or more schools have identical enrollments and are on the lower end of a Classification division, the school(s) having the higher enrollment the previous year shall be assigned to the higher classification/division. NOTE: Number in parenthesis with \*\* equals last year's enrollment number.

### Rule 29 (Cooperative Agreement)

The Executive Board may allow 2 members schools to be combined for interscholastic activity competition and field a common participating group. Examples which constitute need are: insufficient numbers, lack of staff, and lack of facilities. When combined to compete in a team sport, the classification appropriate for the combined enrollment of the schools involved will apply.

NOTE: Class 1A schools Madison and Hamilton when combined become a 2A school.
