

WEEK #9 FOOTBALL POINTS OF CONSIDERATION

REMINDER: Assignments for the regional round have been posted. We will establish locations for the

assignments Saturday evening or Sunday morning.

REMINDER: Bands are not to play (including the beating of drums) or taped (electronic) music and artifi-

cial noisemakers are not to be used while the game is in program (when the ball is marked ready for play by an official until the play has been completed and the whistle blows). The

time permitted is during intermissions, timeouts and after scores.

SITUATION: Refresh yourself with the Free Kick rules related to these kicks. When K kicks off

and uses a pooch kick, can a member of the Kicking team run underneath the ball and catch it? They cannot, as this would be foul. Rember, there is a difference be-

tween a free kick and scrimmage kick. (6-1-6 and 7)

REMINDER: Coaches are permitted to use electronic equipment to communicate to players when the

player is in the team box or during a timeout, which is held outside the 9-yard or 7-yard marks on the field. No individual can be outside the team box and communicate with a coach or player who is in the team box area. The press box is an extension of the coaching

box. The endzone is not an extension of the team area.

REMINDER: Take a look and review the Penalty Summary page of the rule book. This is found on pages

92-93, with the signals on pages 94-95.
