drive. Risk Minimization should always be a priority.

SITUATION: What is the penalty enforcement for a blindside block with forceful contact not initiated with open

hands? (2-32-16) (Penalty Summary) (9-4-3n) What is the signal used for an illegal blindside block?

DEFINITION: What is the difference between targeting and flagrant targeting? How do you handle the difference?

What is the penalty for each? (2-20-2; 2-16-2c)

DEFINITION: What are the three indicators on recognizing a legal hit on a defenseless receiver? (Rule 2-32-16d)

QUESTION: What is the penalty enforcement for a nonplayer being outside the team box? (9-8-3)

REMINDER: ENFORCE THE TEAM BOX FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS ON THE SIDELINE. THIS IS FOR

THE SAFETY OF OFFICIALS AND PLAYERS.

REMINDER: No player shall participate while wearing illegal equipment or not wearing required equipment! (1-5)

2. Eye Shields must be clear, with no presence of tint. (No exceptions to this)

3. Player must wear knee pads, and the knee must be covered at the start of each play.
