| <b>REMINDER:</b> | If any player loses their helmet during a play, then that player is required to leave<br>for one down. This is not a new rule and one that is both an NFHS and NCAA<br>rule. The only exception is if the helmet comes off due to a foul on the<br>opposing player that directly caused that helmet to come off. (1-5) |

| ENFORCEMENT:     | What is considered an illegal blindside block? What is the penalty enforcement? $(9-4-3n)$   |
| <b>REMINDER:</b> | Current NFHS Football Rules state that the eye shield must be "clear without the presence of any tint." The polarized shields are not compliant with the rule.<br>A Doctor does not supersede this rule.<br>(1-5-c4)   |
| ENFORCEMENT:     | What constitutes illegal person contact? What are the enforcements? (9-4)  |
| ENFORCEMENT:     | What constitutes pass interference? It is not forward-pass interference if? (7-5-6,7,8,9,10,11)  |
| <b>REMINDER:</b> | Make sure officials, coaches, and administrators talk before the game regarding emergency action plans, medical personnel for the game and the location of an AED.   |
