**Regional 1** - [Team # 1](#) will get a bye; [Team # 8](#) will play [Team # 9](#).

**Regional 2** - [Team # 2](#) will get a bye; [Team # 7](#) will play [Team # 10](#).

**Regional 3** - [Team # 3](#) will get a bye; [Team # 6](#) will play [Team # 11](#).

**Regional 4** - [Team # 4](#) will play [Team # 13](#); [Team # 5](#) will play [Team # 12](#).

#### SOUTH CENTRAL REGION

Three regional winners will qualify to Quarterfinals, [Tuesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>](#).

**Regional 1** - [Team # 1](#) will get a bye; [Team # 8](#) will play [Team # 9](#).

**Regional 2** - [Team # 2](#) will get a bye; [Team # 7](#) will play [Team # 10](#).

**Regional 3** - [Team # 3](#) will get a bye; [Team # 6](#) will play [Team # 11](#).

**Regional 4** - [Team # 4](#) will play [Team # 13](#); [Team # 5](#) will play [Team # 12](#).

**Most** regional tournaments are four-team tournaments. All first round games will be played at the site of the higher seed (Example: Team 8 vs. Team 9, the game will be played at the site of Team 8 unless their facilities are not adequate). The team with the better seed will be the host team and will contract the game officials. **The final games of the regional will be played at the sites of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> seeded teams (unless their field is not adequate).** The regional manager will contract the officials for the final games. **All tournament games will use three officials** - head referee and two assistant referees (diagonal officiating system). **Use only KSHSAA registered officials.** Refer to the inside front cover of the Soccer manual for the checklist that applies to various squad lists and forms.

## STATE QUARTERFINALS & FINALS

State Quarterfinal games between the four regional winners in the Northeast region and the four winners in the South Central region will be played on **Tuesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>** in their respective geographical areas.

The four state quarterfinal winners will advance to the state tournament to be held at the [Rose Hill HS Athletic Complex, 323 East Schools Street on Friday and Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011](#). [Jim Linot, Athletic Director, of Rose Hill School District will be the tournament manager.](#) There will be two sessions at the state tournament, semifinals and finals. Semifinal matches will be played at **5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., on May 25<sup>th</sup>**. The #1 seed from the Northeast Region will play the #2 from the South Central Region and the #1 seed from the South Central Region will play the #2 seed from the Northeast Region. The team with the highest seeding percentage will play the first semifinal contest. The consolation match will begin at **12:00 noon, Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup>**, followed by the championship match at **2:00 p.m.**
