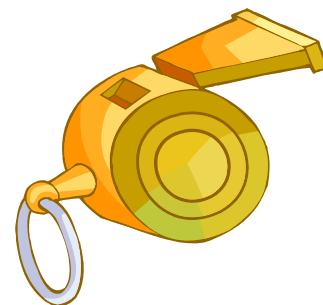


2011 KANSAS VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS CLINICS

- WHO:** **KSHSAA REGISTERED VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS (0 – 5 YEARS REGISTERED ONLY)**
Other inexperienced officials may attend but credit for attendance given only to those registered 0-5 years.
- WHAT:** **9 KANSAS VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS CLINICS**
½ day clinic provides hands-on experience in officiating for volleyball officials registered 0-5 years; clinic features team scrimmage; clinics conducted by KSHSAA Volleyball Area Supervisors; KSHSAA participation in content to provide consistency; NFHS rules/mechanics. (see clinic agenda, page 3)
- WHEN/** **SATURDAY, AUGUST 13** = Cimarron, Clearwater, Hoyt-Royal Valley, Solomon
WHERE: **SATURDAY, AUGUST 20** = Bonner Springs, Clay Center, Haven, Iola, Quinter

- COST:** **ONLY A FEW HOURS OF YOUR TIME** (no pre-registration required- however, for planning purposes, it would be helpful for attendees to contact clinic organizer in advance (see page 2 for contact info))
- ATTIRE/** Comfortable clothes/court shoes (**no uniform necessary**);
BRING: **Please bring** your whistle & personal courtside equipment bag (i.e., line-up card & pencil, red/yellow cards, rule book, flipping coin, etc.)
NOTE: Some gymnasiums are air-conditioned, some are not – so, be prepared.
- WHY** **Because Kansas volleyball players deserve the best officials we can provide!**
ATTEND? Preparation in officiating is never-ending. And there are no short cuts to becoming a competent official. To be a successful official, one must have a complete command of the rules and a fundamental understanding of the game. In addition to court time, these clinics provide the opportunity to learn from one another and develop a strong camaraderie with other officials. All new officials will benefit from these clinics.
- NOTE:** Attendance for officials registered 0-5 years may use the clinic as an Area Supervisor series meeting make-up, if requested. Other inexperienced officials are welcome to attend but will not receive attendance credit.
