ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board received reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick, and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The Executive Director gave a financial report and also an update on the business of the National Federation of State High School Associations following the recent NFHS Winter meeting which Mr. Faflick attended, as well as an update on the business of National Interscholastic Administrators Association following their annual conference and attended by Ms. Martin.

APPEAL BOARD and BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION REMINDER

Member schools are reminded of upcoming elections for positions on the KSHSAA Appeals Board and Board of Directors. A mailing was sent in early January providing information on positions for members of local boards of education and junior high/middle and senior high school administrators. Individuals interested in being candidates for these positions must submit their names to the KSHSAA by February 15. Please see **Bylaws IV and VII** in the Handbook for the required procedures to submit candidate names. The February issue of the Activities Journal contains a special section with this information.

Senior high school principals should note information reminding them to identify their league affiliation and league representatives to the KSHSAA Board of Directors for 2019-2020 was sent to them via email on January 16th.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS APRIL AGENDA DEADLINE REMINDER

Per **Amendments Bylaw, Article XVI** in the KSHSAA Handbook, member schools are reminded **Friday, March 15, 2019** is the deadline to propose KSHSAA Handbook rule changes for consideration by the Board of Directors at their next meeting, April 26-27, 2019.

SPORTS MEDICINE & STUDENT SAFETY

The Executive Board heard a report and discussed concussions and collection of concussion data. Additionally, it was reported a work group of the Sports Medicine Advisory Committee is developing a best practice protocol for schools hosting cross country meets.

KSHSAA "SPIRIT OF SPORT" & "HEART OF THE ARTS" AWARDS

Assistant Executive Director Rod Garman reported on nominations received for this year's awards program. The selection process in determining a state honoree for the KSHSAA award in each category continues to involve the KSHSAA Student Advisory Team. The SAT is in the process of evaluating all nominations received and will select the Kansas recipient in each category. Both Kansas honorees will then be forwarded to the National Federation of State High School Associations as the candidate representing Kansas for consideration for national level awards.

NFHS NETWORK

The KSHSAA will partner with the NFHS Network for a pilot broadcast of the boys state swimming and diving championship this February. This pilot will include the ability to utilize a digital ticketing process via Huddle Tickets.

GIRLS WRESTLING ADDED TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS AGENDA

The Executive Board placed modifications to Handbook **Rule 44 Wrestling (Boys)** and Handbook **Rule 23 Mixed Teams** on the agenda for the April Board of Directors. Such modifications provide opportunity for a state wrestling championship tournament for girls to be conducted annually. Proposed temporary modifications to **Rule 23 Mixed Teams** would allow a transition period for member schools to develop appropriate competition schedules for girls only competition.

GOLF TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Executive Board placed modifications to Handbook **Rule 36 Golf (Girls & Boys)** on the agenda for the April Board of Directors. Such modifications provide opportunity for a 36-hole state championship tournament for golf.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The Executive Board received the request from Wichita Central Christian Academy for membership consideration. Head of School Michael Hunter and Secondary School Principal/Athletic Director Kenny Waddell provided background information as well as projected growth for their school. The Board will make a final decision on membership at an upcoming meeting.

CPR/AED TRAINING FOR COACHES/SPONSORS

The Executive Board placed modifications to Handbook **Rule 10 Qualifications of Coaches (Athletic, Spirit, Scholars Bowl and Speech)** on the April Board of Directors agenda. The proposal includes a requirement for all coaches/sponsors to be certified or trained in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) administration. Additional sport manual information was presented and discussed.

HALL OF FAME

The Executive Board received the minutes and a report following the selection meeting for the 2019 KSHSAA Hall of Fame Committee. Five individuals were selected from 26 qualified nominees. Those selected are official Oscar Birt (Girard), student Marcel Carter (Gainesville, FL), coach Fred Cottrel (Conway Springs), student Perry Ellis (Wichita), and student Erik Nielsen (Hamburg, Germany). More information on these individuals is available on the Gallery of Champions at www.kshsaachamps.org.

PUBLIC/PRIVATE SCHOOLS

The Executive Board received a report from Superintendent Dr. Brian Biermann (Louisburg) and Principal Jeff Hines (Paola) regarding public-private schools. This report included the results of a recent survey conducted by representatives of two member

schools with responses from member school superintendents, principals, and athletic directors. Also included in the report were results of a similar survey conducted in December of 2016 and the KSHSAA Public-Private Study Committee report. The Executive Board requested staff to develop and share (at the upcoming March meeting) a proposed plan and timeline necessary to facilitate engagement of stakeholders needed to address the concerns expressed in this regard.

MANAGED SERVICES

The Executive Board received a report regarding a possible contract for the Association network to be managed by a third party. Staff will continue to review options and will present a more detailed recommendation at an upcoming meeting.

NCAA BASKETBALL RECRUITING

Plans are being developed to allow Kansas high school boys basketball players the opportunity to participate in a recruiting showcase. The new NCAA recruiting guidelines now provide Division I coaches this window for evaluation of prospects. Kansas will partner with Arkansas, Iowa, Missouri, Nebraska, and Oklahoma for an event tentatively scheduled for June 21-23 in Liberty, MO. The KSHSAA will partner with KBCA and KCA to determine the final invite list for this event.

OFFICIALS REGISTRATION FEES

The Executive Board approved a proposal to increase registration fees for officials by \$5 for the next school year. The new registration fee will be \$55.

OFFICIATING FEES

On an annual basis, the Association reviews officiating fees in a planned three year rotation of all sports. KSHSAA staff provided the Executive Board with information on postseason officiating fees in the sports of volleyball, wrestling, baseball, and softball. Staff provided the Board with an analysis of the fiscal impact if fees were to be increased. Following preliminary analysis, the Board referred this item to the agenda of their March meeting for final consideration.

LEAGUE AFFILIATION

The Executive Board received information and discussed a possible league re-alignment for many of the larger schools in the Johnson County area. Additionally, they were made aware of challenges a smaller school is evaluating as they consider membership in a multi-state league.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

The Executive Board received information in discussion format regarding the following items:

1. A correspondence received following the Middle School League Assignment Hearing conducted at the November meeting from Superintendent Gary Price (Hutchinson), and subsequent follow up correspondence and clarification of action/response from the KSHSAA.
2. An eligibility appeal hearing requested by the parents of a transfer student was cancelled by the family. This

also involved a forfeiture required by a member school for playing an ineligible basketball player in a boys contest.

3. Concern expressed by two member schools regarding their inability to have girls wrestle against boys in a double dual hosted by private member school in the Kansas City Diocese per policy of the host school diocese.
4. Follow up to correspondences between the KSHSAA and a member school regarding sportsmanship concerns involving actions of a head coach as part of the state championship football game.

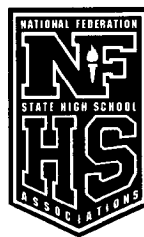
