2016-17 AUDIT REPORT APPROVED

Mr. Musselman presented the Executive Board with the annual certified audit report prepared by Wendling, Noe, Nelson, & Johnson L.L.C. of Topeka. Following Mr. Musselman’s review of the audit, the Board voted unanimously to approve the audit report. The report will be printed in the October 2017 issue of the *KSHSAA Activities Journal*.

The agenda for the regional meetings, with the specific questions to be discussed at each site, will be distributed to member school superintendents, principals and presidents of local boards of education in early October, enabling time for discussion at the local level with staff, boards of education and league meetings.

DAVID CHERRY HONORED WITH NFHS SECTION 5 CITATION

Mr. Musselman reported to the Executive Board that at the recent NFHS Section 5 meeting, the six states which comprise NFHS Section 5 (*Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota and Kansas*) have selected David Cherry to be honored with the NFHS Citation Award at the 2018 NFHS summer meeting. Mr. Cherry becomes the fourth member of the KSHSAA staff to be so honored, as in previous years, Victor Sisk, Rick Bowden and Cheryl Gleason have also received the Section 5 Citation for outstanding service.

REGIONAL WRESTLING TOURNAMENT WEIGH-IN POLICY REVISED FOR 2017-18

Assistant Executive Director Mark Lentz provided the Board with a recommendation to modify the current weigh-in procedure for wrestlers entering KSHSAA regional tournaments. Following discussion, the Executive Board voted unanimously to adopt the following policy which will be published in the *2017-18 KSHSAA Wrestling Manual*:

“Regional teams will weigh-in at the regional tournament locations. Weigh-ins at the tournament site are expected to adhere to NFHS Rule 4-5-2.”

Board members were supportive of the change based on the fact that the regional and state tournaments are one continuous tournament series by rule. Additionally, this change will allow regional tournament officials to administer skin checks in a more consistent and efficient manner.

***Note: It should be noted this change is for regional tournaments only and does not change the weigh-in procedures for regular season competitions.**

FOOTBALL MANUAL CHANGES APPROVED TO ENHANCE SCHEDULING OPPORTUNITIES

Mark Lentz, KSHSAA football administrator, presented the Executive Board members with proposals to address concerns that are being received from member schools having difficulty developing football schedules for the upcoming two year scheduling cycle. Two proposals were discussed and given unanimous approval by the Executive Board. There were:

1. Remove the tiebreaker criteria which addresses “wins in your classification or higher” from the tiebreaking formula. By doing so, schools no longer have that as a factor causing them to avoid scheduling a school outside their classification.
2. Reformat the Class 1A football district and postseason structure to enhance scheduling opportunities for the greatest number of schools possible. To accomplish this, the following will be utilized:
 - a. Week #9 games will be bracket games as in all other classifications
 - b. Class 1A schools will be assigned to eight districts of 3-4 teams per district.
 - c. District competition will begin in week #6 of the football season.

SPORTS MEDICINE UPDATE

KSHSAA staff member Brent Unruh, ATC, reported to the Executive Board on recent activities of the KSHSAA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee. Five new members will be joining the committee at the next meeting on October 9th, as five members rotate off. Mr. Unruh reviewed the recent information released on all state high school associations by the Korey Stringer Institute and reported on the “Collaborative Solutions Conference” conducted in Kansas City last spring which is sponsored in part by the NFHS. Board members discussed the importance of continuing to examine potential changes to KSHSAA rules and policies to address heat acclimatization in exertional activities which take place at the start of the school year. This topic will be a major focus of the KSHSAA Regional Administrator and Board of Education Meetings next October.

LEOTI-WICHITA COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL REQUESTS LEAGUE AFFILIATION HEARING

Principal Delbert Schmidt and Athletic Director Shad Mehl of Wichita County High School in Leoti, appeared before the Executive Board to request the Association assign their school to a league per **Bylaw ARTICLE XV, League Affiliation**, which reads as follows:

Section 1: Any member school not a member of a league or similar organization may apply to the KSHSAA Executive Board for assistance in acquiring league affiliation.

Section 2: The Board of Directors of the KSHSAA shall develop procedures whereby: (1) the requesting school shall submit sufficient evidence to the Executive Board that it has made a conscientious effort to become affiliated with an existing league; (2) if it appears that the Executive Board may take affirmative action on the request, the requesting school and any league to which the school may be assigned shall have an opportunity to be heard by the Executive Board prior to the assignment is made; (3) the Executive Board, after considering all the facts in the matter, may assign the school to an existing league; (4) in the event a school is assigned to a league under the above-mentioned circumstances, no members shall withdraw from that league for a period of three years without unanimous consent of all members of the league including the newly-assigned school, or approval of the Executive Board.

Wichita County High School presented information to the Executive Board outlining their history as member of both the Hi-Plains League and the Northwest Kansas League in the last fifteen years. At the request of the Executive Board, information was reviewed detailing unsuccessful efforts by the school to pursue league membership.

It was the decision of the Executive Board to grant a league assignment hearing at the next meeting of the Executive Board on **Wednesday, November 15, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.** The Executive Board voted to have the members of the **Hi-Plains League and Northwest Kansas League** appear for purposes of this hearing. It was noted, these leagues have similar sized high schools in their membership and most of their member schools are in the approximate geographic area of Wichita County. Superintendents and principals of all schools in the two identified leagues will receive a communication from Mr. Musselman inviting them to attend and participated in the November hearing.

GIRLS WRESTLING PRESENTATION

Doug Kretzer, McPherson, Doug Vanderlinden, Burlington and Nate Naasz of Lincoln requested the opportunity to meet with the Executive Board to report on the current status of girls competing in member school high school wrestling programs. They provided the Board with statistical data regarding current participation indicating 60 member schools had a total of 112 girls participate in the 2016-17 school year. The goal of these coaches is to grow participation by girls to the point that it becomes feasible for schools to offer girls only wrestling events with the future goal of developing a KSHSAA state event. No action was taken by the Board.

2018 BOYS REGIONAL TENNIS DATE MOVED TO MAY 3 & 4, 2018

With the hope of reducing potential schedule conflicts, the KSHSAA published Saturday May 5, 2018 as the date for boy's regional tennis tournaments on its 2017-18 calendars. Subsequently, it has become apparent that by moving the regional tennis date, more conflicts for students in state forensics will be likely. Accordingly, the Executive Board voted unanimously to move the 2018 boy's regional tennis tournaments back to Thursday, May 3 and Friday, May 4 in 2018. In addition, the Executive Board designated that in the event of rain delay in regional tennis tournaments, Saturday May 5th is the designated date to complete the tournament without regard to other schedule conflicts for participating students.

In future years, the KSHSAA will schedule boy's regional tennis tournament dates in SCW #44 in an effort to avoid conflict with state speech contests which fluctuate between SCW #43 and #44 in the spring calendar. It should be noted standardizing calendar dates for spring music and speech activities is not possible due to wide variation in member school calendars which must account for many variable factors including spring breaks.

2017-18 BUDGET APPROVED

Following a hearing held on **Wednesday, September 13, 2017 at 11:30 a.m.** in the office of the KSHSAA, the Executive Board unanimously approved the KSHSAA budget for the 2017-18 school year and authorized its publication and distribution to the member schools.

APRIL 2017 MINUTES APPROVED

Following the Call to Order by President Juan Perez and the roll call, G. Bixler moved, second by A. Stein, to approve the Minutes of the April 28, 2017, Board of Directors' meeting. The motion passed (68-0).

All agenda items passed become effective immediately upon publication of these minutes unless otherwise specified.

NOTE: Words or phrases which appear underlined in the following sections indicate the changes which were made.

PRESEASON BASEBALL PROPOSAL VOTED DOWN

A proposal was made to modify **Rule 30, Seasons of Activities, Section 1, Article 3, and Rule 32, Baseball (boys), Section 2, Article 1** as follows:

Rule 30 Seasons of Activities

Section 1: General Regulations (apply to grades 7-12)

Art. 3: During the school year a coach/coach's aide may only be involved with his/her athletes in a sport during the season.

During the school year, prior to or after season, a coach/coach's aide may not:

- a. Organize or conduct practices or competitions for his/her athletes. However, a coach may be involved in one organizational meeting for a non-school league to assure no more than three of his/her athletes in basketball, six in 11-Man football, five in 8-Man football, four in volleyball, six in soccer, five in baseball, or five in softball are on the same outside team; (See **Rules 32-1, 33-1-4, 35-1-2, 38-1, 39-1, 43-1-1.**)

- b. Practice or compete with or against his/her athletes;

- c. Attend clinics or camps with his/her athletes.

Following the season of sport, seniors may receive instruction from their school coach, in the same sport.

Exception: Beginning with Sunday of Standard Calendar Week #31, through the end of Saturday of Standard Calendar Week #34, a school's baseball coaching staff may work with only pitchers and support players in a catching role, who are not participating in a winter sport, on a voluntary basis in an arm care program no more than two times per week.

NOTE: (For information pertaining to summer coaching restrictions, see **Rule 10-1-6.**) (See summer camp regulations, this section **Art. 6** for exceptions.)

Rule 32 Baseball (Boys)

Section 2: Senior High Regulations

Art. 1: Practice shall not be held prior to Monday of Standardized Calendar Week #35.

NOTE: (See **Exception in Rule 30-1-3.**)

J. Herman moved adoption of the proposal, second by A. Gonzales. The vote was 22 in favor, 42 opposed.

Purpose of Appeal:

Makisha Polk, guardian of a student attending Shawnee Mission East High School, requested the hearing with the Appeal Board. The appeal is from the August 21, 2017 eligibility ruling by the Executive Director per Bona Fide Student Rule 14-1-2 and Transfer Rule 18-1-13. The student is currently attending Shawnee Mission East. He has moved to a new home with Ms. Polk. There has been a family separation. He was originally denied eligibility for the transfer from Shawnee Mission South High School to Shawnee Mission East with no evidence of a permanent bona fide move, and due to determination move was athletically motivated. The Executive Director confirmed the denial by Shawnee Mission South and ruled the student is not eligible per the Bona Fide Student and Transfer Rules.
