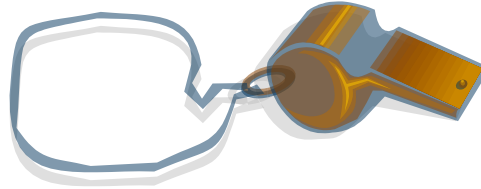


2009 KANSAS VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS CLINICS

WHAT: **10 Kansas Volleyball Officials Clinics**

½ day clinic provides hands-on experience in officiating in addition to a through discussion of playing rules and duties of an official; clinics conducted by KSHSAA Volleyball Area Supervisors; KSHSAA participation in content to provide consistency; NFHS rules/mechanics. -EXP -Ball Handling PP, You Make The Call, Points of Emphasis, Questions, Evaluation |
