CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

LOGO'S

Upon qualification, Coaches will be asked to provide a school logo to be used for identification/media purposes throughout the event.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUNDS

Tournament participants will be allowed one Official Practice Round to be played between qualification from the Regional Championship and Sunday May 22. Practice rounds will cost \$20.00/walking and \$30.00/riding. Call the Golf Shop at 620-221-5645 to schedule.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUNDS

Normal rates will apply for practice rounds prior to qualification from the Regional Championship. Call the Golf Shop at 620-221-5645 to inquire about rates and availability.

RANGE BALLS

There will be no charge for Range Balls. Range Balls will be located on the driving range no later than 1 hour prior to first starting time.

TEEING GROUNDS

Blue Markers will reflect where the Championship will be played from. The tee markers will be placed Tuesday May 17 on the tee box expected to be played during the first round of the Championship based on the weather forecast. The tees will be moved as needed leading up to the Championship to prevent turf damage but will remain on the same tee box. *In the event the weather forecast changes dramatically, the tournament committee can make subsequent changes to the teeing grounds*. The tees will not be moved until the morning of Monday May 24 to protect the integrity of the Championship. Planned changes in tee locations (only when tees are being moved to a separate tee box) for the final round will be communicated to coaches ahead of the event.

COACHES MEETING

A coaches meeting will be held Sunday May 22 at 6:00 in the Clubhouse Outdoor Pavilion area. Prior to this meeting, Coaches with teams/individuals who qualified at Regionals will be e-mailed the official State Championship Conditions of Competition.

LIVE SCORING

Live Scoring will be conducted following the completion holes #6, #9, #12, and #18.

Results will be streamed to a television in the clubhouse.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The Tournament Committee will consist of Brad Sexson, PGA Head Golf Professional – Taylor Humphrey, Pro-Shop Manager – Jeremy Birdwell, Golf Course Superintendent – Justin Deal, Grounds Maintenance – Tim Nihart, Superintendent of Parks & Public Land – Patrick Steward, Director of Public Improvements

ARBITRATION COMMITTEE

An Arbitration Committee comprised of Head Coaches will be named following Regional Championships.

RULES OFFICIALS

Rules Officials will be assigned quadrants on the golf course and be available to assist tournament participants throughout the event. **PERTINENT RULES NOTIFICATION** – Lost Ball and Out of Bounds will be played as Stroke & Distance (tournament participants will be required to return to the spot they last played from). All NATIVE AREAS will be played as Penalty Area's. Pace of Play will be enforced, and guidelines will be communicated to Coaches of teams/individuals upon qualification.

COACHES

Coaches will be identified by a Wristband that Rules Officials would always like to be visible. Coaches will be required to abide by guidelines included in the KSHSAA manual. Any golf car usage will have to be approved by KSHSAA prior to the Championship.

CONTESTANTS ATTIRE/CONDUCT

Coaches will be responsible for contestants' attire. Contestants are expected to respect the golf course, their playing partners, volunteers, spectators, and tournament officials at all times. Any act of unsportsmanlike conduct may result in penalty/disqualification.

MARKERS

Each group will be assigned a Marker. While each contestant will receive a scorecard from the starter, the Marker will have the responsibility to record scores on the official scorecard. Markers are not allowed to interpret or provide any assistance with rulings. Each qualifying School will be asked to provide one Marker.

SEVERE WEATHER

Each groups Marker will be responsible for transportation to and from the clubhouse in the event of severe weather. Severe weather will be communicated by air horn as well as through a message on each golf cars GPS unit. Markers and coaches will be instructed on the official evacuation plan prior to the start of the Championship.

COACHES HOSPITALITY AREA

An area designated Coaches Hospitality will provide refreshments throughout the event.

BOX LUNCHES

Upon qualification, Coaches will be asked to provide a headcount for Box Lunches. Special dietary needs need to be communicated to Quail Ridge Golf Course staff at this time as well. Box Lunches will be available only to those who request them ahead of time at a price of \$8.00 per person.

SPECTATOR GOLF CARS

A limited number of Spectator Golf Cars will be available on a first come first serve basis at a price of \$46.50. Coaches may request Golf Cars to be reserved for those with a Physical Disability prior to the Championship. Call the Golf Shop at 620-221-5645 to reserve a Golf Car.
