No scientific findings indicating spread of COVID19 between athletes on the field of competition
Rapid recent deterioration of Kansas health
Primarily an adult issue
Hospital capacity at max (no transfers)
"Three Headed Monster"
Positivity rate

- Moving indoors
- Other illness on top of COVID19

Athlete mental health – compromised with fear, anxiety
 Strict adherence to mitigation basics necessary
 Pause competition, practice beneficial





Delay <u>competitions</u> for all winter activities until Friday, Jan 15

Allow virtual competition only in Debate and Scholars Bowl



Extend Winter Moratorium Dec 23 – Jan 3. Can resume Jan. 4. No contact between coach/athlete/school No school facility use



In locations where it is appropriate to practice...

- All KSHSAA risk mitigation protocols strictly enforced
- Winter Activities continue practice through Dec 22Winter activities resume practice Jan 4



Tentative resumption of competition

- January 15
- □No fans January 15-28
- Limited fans Jan 29 through remainder of winter competitions

□Mandatory universal masking

- Exception: athletes in competition
- Exception: officials during live action

■No decision on final status of winter postseason earlier than January 15



High School Competition Limitations

No invitational tournaments
Basketball – 13 games
Bowling – 8 matches
Swimming and Diving – 6 competitions/athlete
Wrestling – 12 event max, 20 competition point max



Middle School Restrictions

- □No competition in December, practice only
- □No competition Jan 1-Jan 14
- □No events with more than three schools participating
- Strongly encourage skill development
- Strongly encourage intramural play only
- Limit two fans per player starting Jan 15
