Team/Bus Drop Off and Parking (SEE MAP ON PAGE 5):

Teams will drop off on the east side of the activities complex. The entrance for the team is south of the football field and north of the softball field. Busses should then park in one of the lots <u>north</u> of Lexington Trails Middle School.

Pass Gate (SEE MAP ON PAGE 5):

The pass gate will be located south of the football field and north of the softball field on the east end of the fieldhouse.

Fan and Parent Parking (SEE MAP ON PAGE 5):

All fans and parents should park in the large lot near the high school, south of the tennis courts. *PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE ACCESS ROAD WEST OF THE ACTIVITIES COMPLEX OR IN THE LOTS EAST OF THE FOOTBALL FIELD/NEAR THE MIDDLE SCHOOL.*

Admission:

Artificial Noisemakers

KSHSAA has a strict no-tolerance policy on the use of artificial noisemakers at any time before or during competition. If witnessed being used, the individual/individuals will be escorted out of the facility.

Facility Restrictions:

The De Soto School District is smoke-free, tobacco-free, and alcohol-free (this includes electronic cigarettes/vape devices). Additionally, the facility is a pet-free property and facility. Thank you to teams and all fans for adhering to these restrictions.

Locker Rooms:

Each team will have a designated host that will direct them to their locker room and answer any questions they may have. DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS IN THE LOCKER ROOM. Teams should use locker rooms for pre-game, halftime and post-game only.

Athletic Trainer:

A certified athletic trainer will be available, provided by The University of Kansas Health System. On Friday, the trainer will be Jessica Goodman and on Saturday it will be Kara Steen.

Team Filming Area:

There are 2 options for teams to film. One on top of the storage container between dugouts on the west side of the field. The other is outside of the press box on the east side of the field. **Filming of a game/contest in which your team is not competing is prohibited.** The tournament manager reserves the right to remove individuals who are not operating in an official capacity for one of the final four teams competing.

Media Credentials:

If you have student media needs, please reach out to Michelle Mages in advance, 913-961-0418. We will follow the KSHSAA guidelines for student media access. Students will need to use **their school's** KSHSAA-issued student media passes that were distributed at the beginning of the school year. They must also be listed on their school's Pass Gate List (SC-5 Form) and enter at the Pass Gate. For any questions about media access, please contact Michelle Mages. Only those students or adults with proper credentials and approval will be allowed onto the sidelines between the bleachers and field, or the field itself field.

Concessions:

The DHS booster club will be selling concessions both Friday and Saturday. Concessions is located under the press box on the concourse.

Hospitality:

There will be a hospitality room for coaches, administrators, officials, tournament workers, and bus drivers during both days of competition.

State Soccer Championship Program and Apparel (SEE MAP ON PAGE 5):

KSHSAA State Soccer Championship programs and apparel will be available on the pavilion located south of the football field. Cash and Credit Cards will be accepted.

Warm Up Field:

The football field east of the soccer field will be used for warm up. The higher seeded team will warm up on the south end of the field, the lower seed on the north end. (Turf softball (lower seed) and turf baseball (higher seed) are the back-up locations if our football team is practicing.)

Game Details:

Games will consist of two, forty-minute halves, with a 10 -minute intermission. All seeding and officials are selected by KSHSAA. Reminder, top team, regardless of record will be the home team wearing dark color uniform (visitor will wear white). Home team will be the south end of the field and visitors on the north end.

Participating schools will not be allowed to practice at the tournament site prior to the start of the tournament. We will start the clock with 90 minutes before the first game on both days. Teams may take the field 50 minutes prior to the start of the first contest that day. 50:00 will be placed on the clock for team warm-up and run down to the 10:00 mark. At that point, teams are to prepare for introductions and the National Anthem. Prior to the second game of the day, 30 minutes will be placed on the clock for team warm-up and run down to the 10-minute mark before lining up for introductions. Teams are responsible to bring their own warm-up balls. In the event of inclement weather, a decision will be made by the KSHSAA representative on site and the tournament site manager as soon as possible regarding an altered scheduled or postponement.
