Coaches Seeding Meeting:	<ul> <li>via Zoom at 12:00 pm on Wednesday, October 14th</li> <li>Coaches of <u>all participants</u> are required to attend</li> <li>Zoom link will be sent to participating coaches on Monday, October 12th</li> </ul>
Seeding:	<ul> <li>Seeding procedure will follow the KSHSAA Tennis Manual (p. 25)</li> <li>Records of the regional winners will be posted on the KSHSAA website for review by coaches prior to the seeding meeting</li> </ul>
Tournament Format	<ul> <li>Doubles competition will take place Friday morning through early afternoon</li> <li>Singles competition will begin Friday after @ 2:00 pm or 30 minutes after the last doubles match has concluded</li> <li>Matches identified on the bracket to be played on Friday will take place</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Saturday matches will involve singles &amp; doubles semi and final matches</li> <li>First 2 rounds of main draw = 2 out of 3 sets, regular scoring (10-point tiebreaker for third set)</li> <li>All consolation matches are 9 game, regular scoring (tiebreak @ 8-all)</li> <li>Semi and Final matches = 2 out of 3 with full deuce and full 3rd set, if needed</li> </ul>

Arbitration Committee:	Per KSHSAA guidelines, one coach from each regional will serve
Coaches Wristband:	<ul> <li>Coaches will be required to wear a KSHSAA issued wristband throughout the tournament</li> <li>Coaching may take place during a match on a changeover, when the players split sets or during an injury timeout</li> <li>Only one coach may approach the fence to coach - and they must be identified with a wrist band</li> <li>There will not be a new band for day 2</li> </ul>

Hospitality:	Light breakfast and lunch will be provided on Friday and Saturday for Coaches and Tournament Workers
State T-Shirts And Programs:	Available on site beginning at 9am Friday. Athletes and spectators are encouraged to purchase early as many shirt sizes sell out.
Racket Stringing:	Racket stringing will be available on site. Prices at discretion of stringer.

Team Tents:	<ul> <li>Team tents are allowed in designated areas.</li> <li>Only state qualifiers allowed</li> <li>Practice social distancing and wear masks</li> </ul>
Spectator, Coach & Player Guidelines:	<ul> <li>Players <ul> <li>Practice social distancing and wear a mask when not on court</li> <li>Hand sanitizer will be available on each court</li> <li>Disinfect their racket handles after each mask and wash their hands</li> <li>Bring their own water containers and towels, avoid sharing with others</li> <li>May wear a mask while playing, but are not required to</li> <li>Practice social distancing when reporting to the scores table pre and post match</li> <li>Players will sanitize their hands pre and post match while at the scorers table</li> </ul> </li> <li>Coaches <ul> <li>Practice social distancing and wear a mask</li> <li>Will wear a mask when talking to players on a change-over and between sets</li> <li>Coaches must wear a wristband at all times</li> <li>1 player = 1 coach</li> <li>2-6 players = 2 coaches max</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Spectators</li> <li>Practice social distancing of 6' and will wear a mask</li> <li>Provide own chairs/seats or may set in designated areas only</li> <li>Spectators are asked to leave the area when their player is not playing</li> </ul>
