Parking: Parking will be available in both the north and south parking lots at CBAC

Coaches Seeding Meeting: via Zoom at 12:00 pm on Wednesday, October 14th

- Coaches of all participants are required to attend
- Zoom link will be sent to participating coaches on Monday, October 12th

Seeding: Seeding procedure will follow the KSHSAA Tennis Manual (p. 25)

- Records of the regional winners will be posted on the KSHSAA website for review by coaches prior to the seeding meeting

Tournament Format:

- Doubles competition will take place Friday morning through early afternoon
- Singles competition will begin Friday after @ 2:00 pm or 30 minutes after the last doubles match has concluded
- Matches identified on the bracket to be played on Friday will take place

- Saturday matches will involve singles & doubles semi and final matches
- First 2 rounds of main draw = 2 out of 3 sets, regular scoring (10-point tiebreaker for third set)
- All consolation matches are 9 game, regular scoring (tiebreak @ 8-all)
- Semi and Final matches = 2 out of 3 with full deuce and full 3rd set, if needed

Entries: Submit TNS-2 Form to KSHSAA by Friday, October 23rd

Arbitration Committee: Per KSHSAA guidelines, one coach from each regional will serve

Coaches Wristband: Coaches will be required to wear a KSHSAA issued wristband throughout the tournament

- Coaching may take place during a match on a changeover, when the players split sets or during an injury timeout
- Only one coach may approach the fence to coach - and they must be identified with a wrist band
- There will not be a new band for day 2

Hospitality: Light breakfast and lunch will be provided on Friday and Saturday for Coaches and Tournament Workers

Team Tents: Team tents are allowed in designated areas.

- Only state qualifiers allowed
- Practice social distancing and wear masks

Spectator, Coach & Player

Guidelines:

Players

- Practice social distancing and wear a mask when not on court
- Hand sanitizer will be available on each court
- Disinfect their racket handles after each mask and wash their hands
- Bring their own water containers and towels, avoid sharing with others
- May wear a mask while playing, but are not required to
- Practice social distancing when reporting to the scores table pre and post match
- Players will sanitize their hands pre and post match while at the scorers table

Coaches

- Practice social distancing and wear a mask
- Will wear a mask when talking to players on a change-over and between sets
- Coaches must wear a wristband at all times
 - 1 player = 1 coach
 - 2-6 players = 2 coaches max

Spectators

- Practice social distancing of 6' and will wear a mask
- Provide own chairs/seats or may set in designated areas only
- Spectators are asked to leave the area when their player is not playing
- Johnson County Health Department requirements in place at the time of the event will be followed
