THROW-IN FLOWCHART

After a violation (9-4 through 9-13) by either team, a foul by either team before the bonus is in effect or any other stoppage in play, the throw-in location will be determined by the location of the violation/foul or the location of the ball when the stoppage occurs.

Frontcourt throw-in: One of the established pre-determined spots (28-foot mark along each sideline or 3-feet outside the lane line along the end line).

Backcourt throw-in: designated spot nearest to where the foul, violation or other stoppage.
