

**2021 State Basketball Information**  
**Class 1A-DI– Dodge City - 2/11/2021**

The KSHSAA would like to thank the community of Dodge City for allowing us to host our state basketball tournament at United Wireless Arena. Since our fans are guests of the facility, we ask that all fans abide by the following guidelines.

- Seating will be limited to 600 per school. School administration will be provided the code for people to purchase tickets online and distribute this information to fans. KSHSAA ticket price is \$9.00. In addition, there will be \$3.50 convenience fees for online purchase and credit card processing.
- If all tickets are not sold by the schools, left over tickets will be available on site.
- Masks are required to be worn by all spectators and anyone not on the playing court.
- Six feet social distancing must be maintained in all common areas, public lines, restrooms, and seating.
- Fans living under the same roof may sit together, others must be 6 feet socially distanced.
- The facility will be cleared and cleaned between each contest. A new ticket will be required to attend the second session each day.
- No Helium filled balloons or confetti is permitted in the facility.
- No crepe paper is permitted.
- Spectators are assigned seating locations according to a predetermined assignment made by the KSHSAA, not necessarily based on the seed of the team. Please observe these seating assignments.
- No artificial noisemakers are allowed in the facility.
- All bags are subject to search.
- No spirit props, balls, t-shirts or any other item may be thrown out to the crowd by spirit groups.
- No duct tape is allowed to hang signs. String is recommended on rails. See the United Wireless Arena staff for locations to hang signs.
- All fans are to abide by Rule 52 and display good Sportsmanship.
- Fans must stay off the court after the conclusion of all games.
- No coolers or outside food or drink are allowed in the facility.
- Gates open one hour prior to the first game.
- Credit cards are accepted. There is an ATM available onsite.
