

## 2021 State Basketball Information Class 2A – Manhattan - 2/11/2021

The KSHSAA would like to thank the community of Manhattan and K-State Athletics for allowing us to host the state basketball tournament at Bramlage Coliseum. Since our fans are guests of the facility, we ask that all fans abide by the following guidelines.

- In accordance with KSHSAA policy, Riley County Health Department regulations, and Manhattan City Ordinance, **face coverings are required to be worn at all times in Bramlage Coliseum**, including while seated, except when actively eating or drinking.
- Six feet social distancing must be maintained in all common areas, public lines, restrooms, and seating. Reserved seating assignments are being used to keep 6 feet of distance between pods of fans.
- **No** portable chair-backs may be brought into the Coliseum. **All seating is assigned in either permanent or temporary chairbacks to designate seat locations and social distances.**
- Due to COVID restriction seating will be limited to 800 seats per school, with seating configurations grouped in either two or four reserved seat blocks. No more than four persons may sit together in assigned seats. Ticket purchases will be limited to six seats, one set of four and one set of two seats per person. **Tickets must be purchased in advance at [kstatesports.com](http://kstatesports.com).**
- A school code will be provided to administration for distribution to fans to purchase tickets. Tickets are \$11.00 - KSHSAA ticket price is \$9.00, plus a \$1.00 facility fee and \$1 transaction fee.
- COVID restrictions do not allow access to the Bramlage floor for seating access. Those, with mobility impairment, seeking ADA seating accommodations should contact K-State via email at [tickets@kstatesports.com](mailto:tickets@kstatesports.com) for more information.
- Spectators are assigned reserved seating according to predetermined assignment made by the KSHSAA, not necessarily based on the seed of the team. Please observe these seating assignments.
- **Home team fans will enter NORTHWEST entry gate and will be seated on the east side of the Coliseum, Visiting team fans will enter the SOUTHWEST entry gate and will be seated on the west side of the Coliseum.**
- The pass gate is located at the southwest entrance.
- Coliseum entry gates will open one hour prior to ***each*** game.
- The facility will be cleared and cleaned between each contest. A new ticket will be required to attend the second session each day.
- **K-State's Clear Bag Policy will be in effect. Only clear bags smaller than 12"x6"x12" or "non-clear" clutch bags 5.5"x7.5" are allowed in Bramlage Coliseum under this policy. All persons and bags are subject to search for prohibited items and persons will be asked to unzip their coats for security purposes.**

- No coolers or any outside food or drink are allowed in the Bramlage Coliseum.
- No artificial noisemakers, helium balloons, or confetti of any type is permitted in the facility
- Spirit signs may not be taped to the railings, walls, or seating in the facility. Use string or zip ties to attach signs. Before putting up signs see Host staff or Bramlage staff **for assistance**.
- Spirit signs, face signs, flags and banners mounted to any size sticks or poles are prohibited.
- Banners and flags may not be paraded in the stands or on the floor by fans or spirit groups.
- No spirit props, balls, t-shirts or any other item may be thrown out to the crowd by spirit groups.
- Fans must remain off the floor after the conclusion of all games.
- All fans are to abide by Rule 52 and display good Sportsmanship.
