SUB-STATE TOURNAMENTS

Postseason tournaments will continue this week. Class 1A-DI and 1A-D2 started their quarterfinal games last week. There are games being played every night this week in some class. SUB-STATE ATTENDANCE LIMITATIONS

The maximum attendance allowed at sub-state sites is 50% of the available seats. Each sub-state site will need to determine what 50% capacity is for their facility. If school districts or county health departments have stricter regulations those must be followed. The host school should communicate with the visiting school how many spectators from each school will be allowed. Some schools will use vouchers, some are using pass gate lists, some are using GoFan tickets.

Before going to a sub-state site make sure you check with the host about the availability of seats/tickets. All tickets are \$7.00 for the sub-state tournaments. All games are separate contests, there are no double header games. The facility will be cleared after each game to allow for cleaning. A ticket (if available) will need to be purchased for each game a person wants to attend.

Masks must be worn properly by all in attendance.

Social distancing is required. Therefore, student sections will not be permitted as they have been in the past. If students are in attendance, they must be socially distanced which will reduce the total number of seats permitted. Only those that live under the same roof are permitted to sit together. Others must be socially distanced.

Below is the format information for each classification.

CLASS 1A - DIVISION I AND II TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Class 1A-DI will have 54 schools and Class 1A-DII will have 53 schools per class. These schools will conduct 8 sub-state tournaments of six or seven schools. Grouping are based on a geographical basis after host sites are determined.

- Thursday, March 4, Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII girls will play semifinal contests at the sub-state host site.
- Friday, March 5, Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII boys will play semifinal games at the sub-state host site.
- Saturday, March 6, Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII girls and boys will play final games at the sub-state host to determine which school advances to the state tournament. *Game times will be 2:00 PM Girls and 5:00 PM Boys.

- Monday, March 8 – Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII girls - State Quarterfinal games at the team with the highest winning percentage provided the site meets the KSHSAA guidelines. Games will not be played at schools with restraining lines or very limited seating, an alternative site will need to be located. Quarterfinal state games will be played at team with the best winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Tuesday, March 9 – Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII boys - State Quarterfinal games at the team with the highest winning percentage provided the site meets the KSHSAA guidelines. Games will not be played at schools with restraining lines or very limited seating, an alternative site will need to be located. Quarterfinal state games will be played at team with the best winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Winners advance to primary state site.
- Four teams from each gender will be seeded and state semi-final games will be played at the state site on Thursday, March 11 (Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII girls) and Friday, March 12 (Class 1A-DI and Class 1A-DII boys) Times – 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Facilities will be cleared between contests and cleaned. There is a separate admission for each contest.
- Championship games will be played on Saturday, March 13. Times – 2:00 PM Girls championship game and 6:00 PM boys championship game.
- No 3rd place games will be played. Third place trophies & medals will be awarded to the two teams not advancing to the championship game at the conclusion of the semifinal game.

CLASS 2A and 3A TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Class 2A will have 65 schools and 3A will have 64 schools per class. These schools will conduct 8 sub-state tournaments of eight schools. Groupings are based on a geographical basis after host sites are determined.

- Groups will be numbered one through eight.
- Monday, March 1 Class 3A girls and Class 2A boys will play quarterfinal games at the higher seeded team.
- Tuesday, March 2, Class 3A boys and Class 2A girls will play quarterfinal games at the higher seeded team.
- Thursday, March 4, Class 3A girls and Class 2A boys will play semifinal contests at the sub-state host site.
- Friday, March 5, Class 3A boys and Class 2A girls will play semifinal games at the sub-state host site.
- Saturday, March 6, Class 2A and 3A girls and boys will play final games at the sub-state host to determine which school advances to the state tournament.
- Class 3A girls and Class 2A Boys are at 2:00 PM.
- Class 3A boys and Class 2A girls are at 5:00 PM
- Monday, March 8 – 2A boys and 3A girls - State quarterfinal state games will be played at the site of the team with the higher winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Tuesday, March 9 – 2A girls and 3A boys - State quarterfinal state games will be played at the site of the team with the higher winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Winners advance to primary state site.
- Four teams from each gender will be seeded and state semi-final games will be played at state site on Thursday, March 11 (2A Boys and 3A Girls) and Friday, March 12 (2A Girls and 3A Boys) Times – 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Facilities will be cleared between contests and cleaned. There is a separate admission for each contest.
- Championship games will be played on Saturday, March 13. Times: 2:00 PM – 3A Girls and 2A Boys championships. 6:00 PM – 3A Boys and 2A Girls.
- No 3rd place games will be played. Third place trophies & medals will be awarded to the two teams not advancing to the championship game at the conclusion of the semifinal game.

CLASS 4A, 5A, 6A TOURNAMENT FORMAT

These classes will have 36 schools in each class.

- Games will be played at the higher seeded team.
- Tuesday, March 2 will be semi-finals for 4A Boys, 5A Girls, and 6A Boys at the higher seeded team.
- Wednesday, March 3 will be semi-finals for 4A Girls, 5A Boys, and 6A Girls at the higher seeded team.
- Friday, March 5 will be Sub-state finals for 4A Boys, 5A Girls, and 6A Boys at the higher seeded team.
- Saturday, March 6 will be Sub-state finals for 4A Girls, 5A Boys, and 6A Girls at the higher seeded team. Game time is 3:00 PM.
- Each group will be numbered one through eight.
- Monday, March 8 – 4A Boys, 5A Girls, 6A Boys - State Quarterfinal games will be played at the team with the best winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Tuesday, March 9 – 4A Girls, 5A Boys, 6A Girls - State Quarterfinal games will be played at the team with the best winning percentage of group 1 vs. group 2; group 3 vs. group 4; group 5 vs. group 6; group 7 vs. group 8. Game time 6:00 PM. Ticket price is \$9.00.
- Winners advance to primary state site.
- Four teams from each gender will be seeded and state semi-final games will be played at state site on Thursday, March 11 (4A Boys, 5A Girls, 6A Boys) and Friday, March 12 (4A Girls, 5A Boys, 6A Girls) Times – 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Facilities will be cleared between contests and cleaned. There is a separate admission for each contest.
- Championship games will be played on Saturday, March 13.
 - 2:00 PM – 4A Boys, 5A Girls, 6A Boys
 - 6:00 PM – 4A Girls, 5A Boys, 6A Girls
- No 3rd place games will be played. Third place trophies & medals will be awarded to the two teams not advancing to the championship game at the conclusion of the semifinal game.
