COMPETITION AREA REMINDERS

Please see pages 28-29 in the KSHSAA Bowling Manual for policies regarding coaches, athletes, and non-playing bowlers in the competition area.

-TENPIN BOWLING

<u>Coaches</u>: Coaches shall remain seated in the settee area during competition except to stand to greet a bowler returning from play, spontaneously react to a great play, attend to an injured bowler, move to an adjacent lane.

<u>Non-playing bowlers</u>: These athletes must remain seated in the settee area during competition except to stand to greet a bowler returning from play or spontaneously react to a great play.

-BAKER BOWLING

<u>Coaches and athletes</u>: These individuals may stand in the settee area and at the back of the approach. Non-playing bowlers: These athletes are NOT allowed in the settee area or the back of the approach.
