IMPORTANT STATE INFORMATION

ENTRIES/PASSGATE INFO/TEAM PICTURES DUE TO KSHSAA MONDAY, MARCH 1

The following forms are due to the KSHSAA no later than **MONDAY, MARCH 1**

- **State Entry Form:** Boys = BWL-5; Girls = BWL-6
- **Qualifying Teams:** Picture of 6 team members for state program.

Coaches, please work with your school administrator to get these forms and team picture(s) to the KSHSAA on March 1.

COACH LIMITS @ POSTSEASON

Because of social distancing and limited attendance at postseason bowling tournaments, **school teams are limited to 2 COACHES ONLY** at both regional and state tournaments. At the state tournament, **individual qualifying bowlers will be allowed 1 COACH ONLY**. If a school qualifies 3 individual bowlers, they may have 2 coaches.

LANE ASSIGNMENTS

In following best practices for COVID-19 risk mitigation, the following lane assignments will be used for the 2021 state tournaments:

- **Team Lane Assignments:** This year, qualifying team bowlers will bowl together on 2 lanes. When completing your entry form, please identify the 3 bowlers you would like to place on the odd # lane as 1, 2, 3; identify the other 3 bowlers on the even # lane as 4,5,6.
- **Individual Lane Assignments:** Based on the number of qualifying individuals (6A=16; 5-1A = 28), there will be 2 bowlers on each lane (4 sharing a pair of lanes). Due to the number of qualifiers, this will treat all individual bowlers the same.
- **Lane Assignments for State-**
 - ☐ 6A Individuals = Lanes 1,2,5,6,9,10,13,14
 - ☐ 6A Teams = 1st Place 1=29-30; 2=33-34; 3=25-26; 4=37-38.
2nd Place 1=41-42; 2=21-22; 3=45-46; 4=17-18
 - ☐ 5-1A Individuals = Lanes 1,2,3,4,5,6,9,10,11,12,15,16,17,18
 - ☐ 5-1A Teams = 1st Place 1=29-30; 2=33-34; 3=27-28; 4=35-36; 5=23-24; 6=39-40; 7=21-22
2nd Place 1=45-46; 2=47-48; 3=41-42

LANE ASSIGNMENTS FOR THE STATE TOURNAMENTS WILL BE POSTED ON MONDAY OR WHENEVER ALL SCHOOL ENTRIES ARE SUBMITTED TO THE KSHSAA.

- Bowlers who have rolled a 300 game(s) during the 2021 HS season will participate in rolling a ceremonial ball.
- NEW:** The top 5 highest series per gender and classification (6A; 5-1A) will roll a ceremonial ball.
