2 Sessions: AM = Closest Schools; PM = Remaining Schools

2021 FORMAT

With the presence of COVID-19 and KSHSAA Risk Mitigation Procedures in place, the 2021 Regional Tournaments will have a different look this year.

- There will continue to be 2 sessions at each tournament site, however they will not be gender specific.
- School Teams (Girls & Boys) will bowl together in a POD (side by side on 4 lanes).
- Each tournament will have a max of 8 schools or less due to number of participating schools. KSHSAA rules require that each regional grouping shall have the same number of schools/teams participating insofar as possible. NOTE: 2 of the 6A sites will have 2 girls only school teams.
- The schools will be placed in 2 groups based on mileage from their school to the bowling center.
- The schools designated to be the closest to the tournament site will bowl in the morning; the remaining schools will bowl in the afternoon session.
- The regional results will be determined when comparing the morning and afternoon tournament results.
- All competition will consist of 3 games of American Tenpins followed by 4 Baker games.
- When teams are finished, the center will be cleared and cleaned for the next session.

REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS AND STATE QUALIFIERS (Team & Individuals)

CLASS 6A: There will be 4 regional tournament sites.

- The top two Girls and top two Boys teams at each regional site, will qualify for the state tournament.
- If a team qualifies for state competition, all six members shall qualify. **NOTE:** Qualifying teams may change their team members from regional to state competition.
- If a school enters fewer than four participants at a regional tournament, they shall compete for individual honors.
- The top four highest individual scores that are not members of a qualifying team will qualify for the state tournament in both the Boys and Girls Division.

CLASS 5-1A: There will be 7 regional tournament sites.

- The first place Girls and Boys team at each regional will qualify for the state tournament.
- Three second place finishers with the highest scores will advance to the state tournament.
- If a team qualifies for state competition, all six members shall qualify. **NOTE:** Qualifying teams may change their team members from regional to state competition.
- If a school enters fewer than four participants at a regional tournament, they shall compete for individual honors.
- The top four highest individual scores that are not members of a qualifying team will qualify for the state tournament in both the Boys and Girls Division.

- 88 bowlers will qualify for 5-1A state competition in each gender.
- Class 6A = 8 teams of 6 (48) + 16 individuals
- Class 5-1A = 10 teams of 6 (60) + 28 individuals
