Girls Golf Regional Assignments

Assignments were posted on September 26th.

Refer to page 27 of your golf manual for the criteria in which assignments are determined.

Regional Entries

Entries will be done the same way as in years past. Schools will fill out GLF-1 form online by October 5th. From there the regional host will use their KSHSAA login to view the entries to put into the Kansas Golf Scores System.

While we do not have a qualifying standard for regionals, schools should verify the varsity caliber golfers are sent to regionals.

Girls Golf Classifications

General classification numbers will begin to be submitted September 20. At that time girls golf will utilize the 40/60 rule. Forty percent of the schools playing girls golf that are 4A-1A will be classified 4A for girls golf postseason. The remaining 60% will be 3-1A. This was put into play in 2018 when to help with the distribution of participation at those classification levels. The breakdown is listed on the regional assignments page.

Local Rule

The local rule for lost ball and out of bounds will be used for the girls postseason including regionals and state.

USGA Rule of the Week

Rule: 4.1a(2) Conforming club damaged during a round or while play is stopped (under Rule 5-7a).

2019 Outcome: A player normally must not replace a club damaged during a round (or while play is stopped) except in limited cases.

2023 Outcome: Except in cases of abuse, the player may repair or replace any damaged club with another club.
