The week prior to the tournament: call to schedule tee times anytime, cost - **\$9.50** for 18 holes

Saturday prior to the tournament, Oct. 17th: call for tee times **after 11am**, cost - **\$15** for 18 holes

Sunday prior to the tournament, Oct. 18th: call for tee times **after 11am**, cost - **\$15** for 18 holes

Range balls: available any time, **\$3.50** for small bucket, **\$5.00** for large bucket

Carts: **\$15.00** per person for 18 holes

Coaches/ Parents Practice Round Price: \$15

As you play your practice round, be aware of the following difference for tournament day:

HOLE #15 WILL BE USED AS HOLE #10 ON THE BACKSIDE FOR STATE PLAY

Covid Changes:

Masks will be required in the clubhouse for all people, with zero exceptions. Coaches meeting will take place via zoom on Sunday evening at 7 pm. We will still have food sales as normal, but will ask people to take food outside to eat. Range balls/warm up time will be available, but we will ask coaches to be considerate of other teams/players. Please allow no more than 45 minutes to warm up.

Tournament Day:

The tournament will take place on **Monday and Tuesday, October 19th & 20th starting at 10:00 AM**. If inclement weather postpones the event, we will shorten to an 18 hole score.

Play will be conducted at the **Emporia Golf Course 5 miles south of Emporia. Address 1133 HWY99.**

Coaches meeting will take place at **7:00 PM via zoom.**

Arbitration committee members will be introduced along with the Professional at EGC followed by the traditional information concerning play.

Markers meeting *No markers this year*

Range balls: **\$3.50** for small bucket, **\$5.00** for large bucket

Tournament Day Continued:

Tee Times: Play will begin at **10:00 AM** off holes #1 and #10 at 10 minute intervals.

(AGAIN, HOLE #10 will be the hole that is normally #15)

Attire: All participants will be expected to follow KSHSAA guidelines for attire during, and after, the event. Please

refer to Page 8 of the Golf Manual for questions concerning appropriate attire.

Scoring: Unofficial 9 hole scores will be recorded at the turn for all players.

Copies of the final results will be printed for coaches at the conclusion of the medals ceremony. If an email copy is desired addresses should be left with Marcus before leaving the course.

Spectators: All spectators will be expected to follow the **KSHSAA Spectator Guidelines for Golf**. Additionally, the EGC will ask that all spectators stay on the cart paths during the course of play and keep up with their group to prevent delays in play with the group following.

Food: The Emporia Golf Course respectfully requests that outside food and drinks not be brought to the course.

******If you bring your own cooler, they are not to be left out on the grounds around the clubhouse.**

If you choose to bring them, they must be left in a vehicle in the parking lot. Players would have access to them in transition from front to back nine.

Players will have a brief break at the turn to purchase food from the clubhouse.

Lunch options will include the following deal for **\$6.00**:

1. Hotdog/Sandwich/Brat (Choose 1)
2. Bag of Chips/Candy (Choose 1)
3. Drink

Payment can be made by check (to Emporia Golf Course), credit card, or cash.

State Tournament Shirt Sales: A table will be set up to sell state golf t-shirts, prices will be posted.

Awards: At the conclusion of play, medals for the top twenty (and ties) will be presented along with team trophies. After the awards and pictures, any and all playoffs will take place.

Carts: Available for spectators at \$40. **NO CART RESERVATIONS WILL BE TAKEN**, it will be strictly

first come first served for cart rentals. Personal carts may be brought in and used at no cost.
