

Seminars for Athletic/Activity Administrators 2022

In an effort to serve the needs of school activities administrators, the KSHSAA annually conducts a series of seminars. The seminars will highlight <u>Handbook Rule Interpretations</u> applicable to veteran and new athletic directors.

We will once again offer two seminar dates designed for new administrators. These full-day seminars will include the same information as the shorter, half-day seminars and will include more detail on topics necessary to help new athletic directors get started.

Who should attend?

Everyone who works with administration of KSHSAA activities will benefit. This seminar is a must for first year administrators or those new to Kansas.

The seminar is designed to help you **avoid problems and violations** in the administration of your school activities programs. You may save embarrassment, ineligibility for students and school violations by improving your understanding of KSHSAA rules, policies and procedures.

NEW in 2022 – REQUIRED Administrator Rules Meeting

At least one administrator (Principal or Athletic/Activity Director) from each KSHSAA member school is required to attend a rules meeting taking place on the same day/at the same site as the seminar. This meeting will cover only Transfer Rule 18 in 2022. The required component will begin at 8:30 a.m. and registration will be taken at that time. Schools who do not send an administrative representative to the required portion of the meeting will be fined \$100.
