

## KSHSAA State Championships 2020 – Boys Soccer

**5A @ Spring Hill High School** = November 6 & 7 (Friday & Saturday)

Friday Semifinals are at 4:00 and 7:00 p.m. / Saturday Consolation Finals = 12:00 and Finals = 3:00 p.m.

Spectator capacity will not exceed 50%: 500 spectators per contest will be allowed @ Spring Hill High School.

### COVID-19 Protocols for Spectators/Fans – PLEASE READ & RESPECTFULLY FOLLOW.

- Face masks are required.
- Self-temperature check prior to attending.
- If feeling ill/experiencing any COVID symptoms, stay home.
- Spectators attending the second game each day, please arrive no earlier than 30-minutes prior to game time (on Friday this will be 6:30 p.m. and on Saturday 2:30 p.m.); this will help reduce congestion in the facility allowing for social distancing and sanitization of the seating areas.
- Be prepared to social distance at gates upon entrance.
- Spectator/bleacher areas will be designated by school and clearly labeled to keep school communities separate.
- Spectators will be encouraged to sit in family units with 6 feet social distancing from others.
- Crowds will exit between games each day to allow cleaning/sanitizing of spectator/bleacher areas, also to reduce crowd size per game and help with social distancing.
- Spectators will not be allowed on the playing field after games.
- Restrooms will be cleaned/sanitized regularly.
- Concessions will meet sanitization and safety protocols; prepackaged/bottled items will be sold.
- Be prepared to social distance in concession/merchandise lines.



### Teams/Officials/Workers and General Info

- Schools/teams will temperature check and self-screen prior to boarding buses each day.
- Participants are to wear face masks at all times. (optional during actual game play on the field)
- Event staff/workers will wear face masks at all times.
- Press box/media area will be addressed for social distancing.
- Each of the four schools/teams will have designated team areas/locker rooms & restrooms; these areas will be cleaned/sanitized regularly.
- Bench/sideline areas may be increased to help maintain social distancing for teams.
- Benches/sideline areas will be cleaned/sanitized between games.
- No community/team water jugs will be provided; each player is to have his own water bottle.
- Balls will be cleaned/sanitized during games, and different balls will be used each game.
- Schools/teams will use own balls for warm-ups.
- Athletic trainer will be onsite each day.
- Officials/workers will temperature check and self-screen prior to arrival.
- Officials are to wear face masks at all times. (optional during actual game play on the field)
- Modifications to pregame meetings, introductions, and award ceremonies will be made to mitigate risk.
- Digital ticketing will be utilized via GOFAN website and app.
