PRESEASON REQUIREMENTS

- Students and coaches must complete Concussion & Head Injury Requirements.
- Fall coaches must complete Heat Illness Prevention Education.
- All Coaches (head and assistant) must complete Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) training.
- Heat Acclimatization Policy – Must be followed.
- Must have student physical, concussion form, COVID form (all medical forms) prior to practicing.
- Each student must participate in 9 practices prior to any competition.

RULE 22 – OUTSIDE COMPETITION

Excerpt:

Once a student begins practice with a school team, he/she may not participate on an outside/club team.

This is a change for fall soccer athletes who in the past could continue playing on an outside/club team through Labor Day even though they had already begun practicing with their school team.

Be certain to read and be familiar with the entirety of KSHSAA Rule 22.
