Dear Coaches,

Congratulations on advancing to the 2021 KSHSAA Boys 4A State Wrestling Tournament! On behalf of the City of Salina and Tony's Pizza Events Center, welcome! We look forward to hosting you and your team February 27, 2021. Please review the following information as you prepare for your travel and arrival to the venue. Please share the appropriate information with your administration, athletes, media and spectators.

I. COVID-19 Update:

During this pandemic, our first concern is to always offer a healthy and safe environment for our guests. We will achieve this goal by performing regular disinfecting of all venue surfaces that guests come into contact with, especially door knobs, hand rails, concession stands and restrooms. Our focus is to ensure we meet our guests' needs while doing our part to keep you, our communities, and our employees safe. Our city and venue requires all guests to comply with social distancing and health policies. All guests are required to wear a mask upon entry and inside the venue per Salina City Ordinance No. 20-11034. Face Masks will be available to purchase at our box office for \$1.00.

II. Timeline/Venue Access Times:

9:00 am-West Pass Gate (backstage) open for Wrestlers, Coaches, Officials & Tourn. Assist.

11:00 am - West Pass Gate (backstage) open for Cheerleaders and Media.

11:00 am - Doors open for General Admittance & North Pass Gate for Administration.

12:00 pm - Tournament Begins

III. Parking:

Parking is free at Tony's Pizza Events Center. We ask that all busses park in our West Parking Lot. Please leave our backstage drive and circle drives open for access. Circle drives are for dropping off guests, but should not be used for long term parking.

IV. Entry/Re-Entry:

Please advise your administrators and spectators to arrive early to avoid any delays entering the arena. If you need to exit the arena, you will be required to have a stamp, your ticket and go through a security check for re-admittance. Please see the usher at the entrance to receive a stamp for reentry.

V. Pass Gates: (see map)

The West Pass Gate will be available for Wrestlers, Coaches, Officials, Media, Cheerleaders and Tournament assistance only. The North Pass Gate will be available for Administrators and Spectators. Note: Cheerleaders MUST be in uniform to be admitted. Bus Drivers MUST be on the school pass gate list to be admitted, otherwise they will have to buy a ticket to the tournament.

IMPORTANT: YOU MUST BE ON THE PASS LIST TO ENTER WITHOUT A TICKET. IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE PASS LIST, YOU MUST PURCHASE A TICKET. NO ADDITIONS OR SUBSTITUTIONS ARE TO BE MADE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL THROUGH THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER.

VI. Tickets/Spectator Seating:

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, KSHSAA and Tony's Pizza Events Center have put the following ticketing procedures into place for the 2021 State Wrestling Tournament: Each attendee is required to have a voucher that will be redeemed at the Tony's Pizza Events Center Box Office (open at 10:00am). YOU MUST EXCHANGE YOUR VOUCHER FOR A TICKET.

- All seating is RESERVED and socially distanced.
- Face masks or coverings are required at all times by KSHSAA and City of Salina ordinance.
- No more than 6 individuals may be seated together.

VII. Luxury Box Seating (Loge Boxes):

A limited number of Loge Boxes are available to rent. Rental fees are in addition to tickets. Call 785-826-7200 and ask for Marjorie Anderson for details and availability.

VIII. Administrators and Cheerleaders Seating:

There are no student sections allowed at this tournament. We have reserved a section (see arena seating map for seating location) that is socially distanced for School Administrators and Cheerleaders to sit in during the tournament. You must be on the pass gate list to sit in this reserved seating. Cheerleaders must sit in the reserved section, and will only be allowed on the tournament floor during the championship finals.

IX. Food & Beverage/Athlete Coolers:

NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE IS ALLOWED to be brought into the facility, with the exception of the participating athletes. Each Wrestler may bring in (1) 18"x14"x14" Soft Side Cooler (no large rolling coolers or large plastic coolers allowed). Coolers are to be kept in their team pod on the bleachers. All participants are allowed to eat their snack or concession food in their seats on the bleachers, but we please ask that for health and safety reasons that all trash be thrown away in the trash receptacle and not thrown on the floor.

X. Hospitality:

Hospitality Vouchers will be provided to Coaches and Officials only. Approved Hospitality members will be provided with a voucher upon check-in at the pass gate, to be redeemed at the concession stand. There will be a priority line at the concessions for all voucher holders.

XI. Lost or Stolen Items:

Tony's Pizza Events Center is not responsible for valuables that are lost or stolen at the tournament. If you have an item that is lost, please see a member of security or check with our North Box Office to see if it has been found. You may also contact our office at (785) 826-7200.

XII. Showers:

The venue offers shower access in Locker Room#140A. The venue does NOT provide towels for the locker rooms, showers or team benches, so please be prepared to bring your own. Please keep our shower area clean of debris after showering. Others will need to use the facilities as well.

XIII. What is allowed in the venue?

For a full list of our prohibited items, please check our website at www.tonyspizzaeventscenter.com

- Banners and/or signs should only be hung from arena railing system (bottom rail only) and cannot be attached with tape. Zip ties and/or string is preferred. Size must not exceed 4ft. x 12ft. Any banners taped to the arena rails, left over night or those that exceed the size limit will be taken down by arena staff. All signs must be removed each day. Venue not responsible for any signs not removed.
- 2. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE IS ALLOWED. (See IX. Food & Beverage section for details)
- 3. No artificial noisemakers or props are allowed at postseason tournaments.
- 4. Helium balloons and confetti are not allowed in the arena.
- 5. Face/body paint application is not allowed in the building.
- 6. Guests/fans will not wear or bring signage with obscene or indecent messages.
- 7. Guests/fans will enjoy an event that is free of disruptive behavior, foul or abusive language or obscene gestures. All fans are to abide by Rule 52 and display good Sportsmanship.
- 8. Cheerleaders and school administrators are to see that students do not stand on chairs. Schools will be held responsible for any damage to chairs or other property where the damage is directly attributable to the school.

Guests are encouraged to communicate discreetly and quickly with Tony's Pizza Events Center personnel if assistance is needed in dealing with unruly guests, any issues, concerns or requests of a clean-up in their area. 


