The Executive Board of the Kansas State High School Activities Association met on Wednesday and Thursday, January 22-23, 2025, with the following in attendance: President Casey Seyfert, Geoff Andrews, Eric Cooper, Shelby Green, Alan Penrose, Jim Porter, Travis Powell, Donald Raymer, Sara Richardson, Delvin Strecker, and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. Assistant Executive Directors Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Rod Garman, Kyle Doperalski, Sarah Smith, Megan Hagaman, Director of Operations Brent Unruh, and Director of Officials Scott Goodheart were also present. Board members David Abel, Gina Knapp and Connie Redic were absent both days. Assistant director Mark Lentz was absent on Wednesday, January 22 as he attended a flag football rules meeting in Indianapolis, IN.

CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

The following items were all approved unanimously via consent:

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

The Board received reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick, and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The Executive Director gave a financial report in conjunction with Financial Services Director Lori Brock and provided an update on the business of the National Federation of State High School Associations following the recent NFHS Winter meeting, as well as an update on the business of National Interscholastic Administrators Association following their annual conference. Other items included a legislative update, legal update, a board election timeline, and recent correspondences and presentations of interest.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS and APPEAL BOARD ELECTION REMINDER

Member schools are reminded of upcoming elections for positions on the KSHSAA Board of Directors and Appeal Board. An email was sent on January 15 providing information on positions for members of local boards of education and junior high/middle and senior high school administrators. *Individuals interested in being candidates for these positions must submit their names to the KSHSAA by February 15.* Please see **Bylaws IV and VII** in the Handbook for the required procedures to submit candidate names. The spring issue of the *Activities Journal* will contain a special section with this information.

Senior high school principals should note information reminding them to identify their league affiliation and league representatives to the KSHSAA Board of Directors for 2025-2026 was sent to them via email on January 24.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS APRIL AGENDA DEADLINE REMINDER

Per **Amendments Bylaw, Article XVI** in the KSHSAA Handbook, member schools are reminded **Friday, March 14, 2025**, is the deadline for member schools to propose KSHSAA Handbook changes for consideration by the Board of Directors at their next meeting, April 24, 2025.

KSHSAA HALL OF FAME – CLASS OF 2025

The Executive Board received a report following the selection meeting for the 2025 KSHSAA Hall of Fame Committee. Five individuals were selected from 27 qualified nominees which included 3 in the Administration category, 5 Contributors, 12 Faculty/Coach, and 6 Student nominations. Those selected are student Beverly Birney, Grinnell; coach Steve Bushnell, Topeka-Seaman; coach CJ Hamilton, Silver Lake; coach Dave Hawley, Wichita-Collegiate; and contributor Klaus Kollmai, Wichita. Respective induction ceremonies are being scheduled in conjunction to honorees wishes. More information on these individuals is available at the Gallery of Champions at www.kshsaachamps.org.

FALL ACTIVITY POSTSEASON UPDATES

Staff provided the Board with a recap of culminating/championship events concluded after their last meeting. Events discussed included:

- a. **GameDay Spirit Showcase – Dance and Cheer** – The discussion reflected new team allowances and spectator attendance allowances due to setup at the Topeka Stormont Vail Event Center and the contract allowances between Varsity Spirit and the event center surrounding food allowances and policing of student participants entering the facility.
- b. **Football Championships** – Staff gave an overview of learning from the new format for championship games. Discussion centered on logistics for running multiple games at a site and continuing to provide the best experience for student participants.
- c. **2-Speaker and 4-Speaker Debate Championships** – The postseason championship locations were discussed along with number of entries and schools in the smaller school classifications.

POTENTIAL MARKETING PARTNER PRESENTATIONS

Representatives from two national marketing companies were invited to present specifics of a potential partnership with the KSHSAA. Each company detailed how they might integrate the mission of the Association into statewide marketing efforts. The presentations introduced possible opportunities for businesses to connect their brand to the KSHSAA. Following discussion, the Board authorized staff to move forward to secure the best and final offer from the preferred partner with the expectation of legal counsel to review any contractual agreements.

KIAAA CLASSIFICATION FORUM

The Executive Board reviewed an opportunity to submit items to the KIAAA Classification Forum which is part of the annual KIAAA Conference each spring. The conference will be in March at the Manhattan Conference Center. Bill Faflick will serve as the staff liaison to the KIAAA Board of Directors.

These items were approved to forward to the KIAAA for feedback:

1. **(Baseball & Softball)** - Should the KSHSAA modify the postseason format in postseason baseball and softball to mirror recent changes made in volleyball and basketball for classes 3-1A.

2. **(Track & Field)** - Should the KSHSAA modify **Track & Field Rule 42-1-4(b)** to allow ~~two~~**four** school competitions to start prior to 3:00 p.m. CST?

In addition, the following items (from regional meetings) have been sent to the KIAAA and the KCA for additional specificity to be developed on an activity specific basis:

3. **(General Quasi-team Sports)** Should factors other than geography be used in establishing regional assignments?
4. **(General Team Sports)** Should something other than W/L record be used in establishing postseason assignment?

OFFICIATING FEES

On an annual basis, the Association reviews officiating fees in a planned three-year rotation of all sports. The Board was given a history of this rotation and a preview of information to be provided at the April Executive Board meeting for final consideration. The current rotation of activities are Cross Country, Football, Gymnastics and Soccer.

SPORTSMANSHIP/BEHAVIOR

Staff reviewed seasonal sportsmanship and behavior concerns including current winter season activity ejection data which reflected a decrease in basketball ejections, and a fairly flat trend in wrestling.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR RULES MEETING REQUIREMENT

Executive Director Bill Faflick requested the Executive Board approve the mandatory rule meeting for member school athletic directors again next school year. The 2024 rules meetings provided an overview of new protocols, rules, and legislative matters affecting KSHSAA. Following discussion, the Board voted to continue with this required meeting to be held in late July and early August 2025. Additionally, the Executive Board determined this expectation shall be an annual requirement. The schedule of these meetings will be developed and available for member school leaders no later than May 1 annually.

DEBATE AND OUTSIDE COMPETITION RULE

Staff led discussion relative to an increasing concern in debate which impacts students who choose to extend their season following the state tournament by attending an approved national tournament.

Handbook **Rule 22 Outside Competition** indicates each season begins with the first practice attended after SCW #7 and ends at the conclusion of his/her last competition for each individual debate team member. **Rule 22** also details a student who is a member of a school athletic, scholars bowl or debate squad effective Monday SCW #7 through Friday preceding Memorial Day may not participate as a member of an outside team or as an independent competitor in the same sport, scholars bowl or debate activity. The debate manual indicates that the debate season concludes after SCW #28 and the conclusion of the state debate tournament but also maintains the "National Tournament Qualifiers Exception" which allows students who qualify for an approved national tourney the opportunity to participate in an additional three debate activities beginning SCW #30, not to exceed five total spring competitions. This allows those students dress-rehearsals prior to nationals. During this period, some students are entering additional tournaments as independent competitors claiming this does not violate **Rule 22** as it is conducted after the state tournament.

Following discussion, the Board voted to detail the interpretation on **Rule 22** in the Debate manual to explain that each student planning to attend a national tournament is limited to no more than five such tournaments following state, and that any independent participation in additional or non-sanctioned tournaments render the student(s) ineligible for the national tournament.

STATE BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Based upon membership voting at the 2023 October regional meetings, the Executive Board asked staff to develop a plan to allow multiple championships to be conducted at the same venue. Such a modification has been realized for football and soccer and implemented this school year. Due to the complexity and contract status for basketball championships, the implementation was delayed as an RFP for host basketball facilities was completed. Through this process, challenges became apparent to some host sites who communicated reluctance to commit their facility and staff to conduct four consecutive days of eight basketball games per day at each championship venue. Such concern was based upon a desire to provide championship quality experiences for students and school communities. Accordingly, staff developed an alternative to extend the championship week by playing quarterfinals earlier in the week at geographically diverse facilities around the state. Following review and discussion, the Executive Board determined the best option is to have the benefits and details of the alternative schedule fully developed, presented, and discussed at the 2025 October Regional meetings. Until a feasible option is developed and vetted through broader discussion, the Executive Board plans to remain with seven championship sites.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES

Discussion was held as to what role the KSHSAA should play relative to the ever evolving “fourth season”, or summer months. Topics included coach/athlete contact, moratoriums, risk mitigation guidance/rules, health and wellness, supervision, and more. KSHSAA SMAC has discussed burnout and other mental wellness stressors which may be exacerbated by summer participation in multiple activities. While no action was completed on this topic by the Executive Board, the discussion will continue.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS AGENDA ITEM

Following a brief update, the Board directed staff to place the following items on the agenda for the April 24th Board of Directors Meeting:

1. **Election of Representatives** to the Executive Board for classes 5A, 3A, 1A, Board of Education, and any expiring terms (due to term limits, retirement, job change, etc.).
2. **Seasons of Activities Rule 30** modification for dual sport athletes (approved at November 2024 meeting).
3. **Esports** creation as an activity.

DRONE POLICY

Staff reviewed the proposed amendments during the second read of the existing KSHSAA Drone Policy (the first read was conducted at the November Exec Board meeting). The amendments provide limited opportunities for the use of a drone in capturing game footage for use by school coaches. Following discussion, the amended policy was approved for implementation with the fall season of the 2025-26 school year. The full policy follows:

Prohibiting the Use of Drones (Unmanned Aircraft Systems or UAS's)

Unless granted special permission by the KSHSAA Executive Director, the use of drones (UAS) for any purpose is not permitted at any KSHSAA state tournament or postseason game or event. This prohibition applies to all fields of play, courts, arenas, mats, gym floors or pools, and includes a ban on the entire facility being used as part of the KSHSAA event, including the spectator areas and parking areas. During the regular season, member schools should have a drone policy. At no time should a drone be on or over the field of play.

If granted permission by the KSHSAA Executive Director, a drone may be utilized for filming purposes under the following conditions:

1. Local law enforcement and host venue policies permit use of a drone.
2. The drone operator complies with all FAA regulations.
3. The host school provides written permission.
4. The venue owner provides written permission.
5. The drone is operated under the supervision of a school staff member (including a member of the coaching staff).
6. The drone is operated such that it is never closer than 30' from the boundary of the field of play projected vertically.
7. The drone is never operated directly over or within 30' of spectator seating.
8. The drone is never operated directly behind a goal.
9. The flight of the drone is within 5' of the center of a vertical cylinder (it is "tethered").
10. The drone is grounded whenever the wind speed exceeds 30 mph or whenever the pilot cannot maintain operation within the allowable vertical cylinder.
11. The drone operator/owner provides proof of third-party aviation liability insurance.
