# MINUTES

**Executive Board Meeting  
KSHSAA Board Room  
Thursday, March 14, 2024**

The Executive Board met in the office of the Kansas State High School Activities Association on Thursday, March 14, 2024, with the following in attendance: President Justin Seuser, Justin Briggs, Rick Byers, Shelby Green, Eric Hofer-Holdeman, Deena Horst, Travis Powell, Casey Seyfert, Linda Wiley, Paul Zuzelski and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. Assistant Executive Directors Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Craig Manteuffel, Rod Garman, Kyle Doperalski, Sarah Smith, Director of Operations Brent Unruh, and Director of Officials Scott Goodheart were also present. Board members Kellen Adams and Alan Penrose were absent both days.

### **EXECUTIVE BOARD VICE-PRESIDENT ELECTED**

Local Boards of Education representative Mike Kastle, Parsons, resigned from his position on the Board of Directors and Executive Board, as well as from 2023-24 Board Vice-President position due to no longer serving on the Parsons USD 503 Board of Education. Following notification of the open officer position, the Board elected Casey Seyfert, Beloit, as Vice-President for the remainder of the 2023-24 school year.

### **PUBLIC FORUM**

### **CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS**

The following items were all approved unanimously via consent:

### **ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS**

The Executive Board received reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick, and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reported on the culmination of winter activities and plans for the upcoming spring activity season. The Executive Director gave a financial report as well as an update on any legal and legislative activities that may impact Kansas schools and the Association.

### **LIABILITY AND CATASTROPHIC INSURANCE**

Kent Miller and Karon Wintrode of Willis Towers Watson Insurance spoke with the Executive Board and gave an update on information pertaining to liability, catastrophic and medical coverage for member schools of the KSHSAA for the 2024-25 school year. The Board requested WTW take the current policy to the insurance market for more competitive proposals from other vendors besides the current one utilized. Because proposals were still incoming, WTW did not bring a recommended program to the Board for 2024-25 but will provide a formal proposal and quote along with any program changes for the next meeting of the Executive Board. The Board confirmed they would like WTW to continue moving forward with a new vendor if it is cheaper and provides equivalent coverage.

### **POSTSEASON OFFICIATING FEES**

Staff presented Executive Board members with historical background on game fees paid for officials working postseason contests. The Association has been on a three-year rotation when looking at fees paid and per this traditional schedule, in 2024, basketball, cross country, football and gymnastics officials pay rates were to be reviewed. This discussion was tabled until the April Board of Directors meeting.

## **WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP REVIEW**

Staff led the Executive Board in a discussion regarding the success and challenges with each of the recently completed winter championship events. This opportunity allowed Executive Board members to provide suggestions for modification and future enhancements regarding postseason sites and procedures.

## **KANSAS ACADEMY OF MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE**

Representatives from the Kansas Academy of Mathematics and Science (KAMS) were present to discuss the possibility of participation for their students in KSHSAA activities. Following discussion on possible scenarios providing for dual enrollment, non-public school participation, and cooperative agreements, the Board determined state statute 72-3902 provides for the operation of KAMS to be governed by the Kansas Board of Regents. Because of this, the Executive Director was directed to reach out to KBOR and bring more information and ideas for inclusion to their April Executive Board meeting.

## **DUES APPROVED FOR 2024-2025**

The Executive Board voted unanimously to continue member school dues at the current level of \$500 senior high and \$200 middle/junior high for the 2024-25 school year. KSHSAA membership materials will be mailed in May to building principals and superintendents of all member schools.

The Executive Board also voted unanimously to continue Approved School dues at the current level of \$200 for the year with an optional (additional) fee of \$50 for those participating in debate.

## **KSHSAA COACHING SCHOOL**

Assistant Director Mark Lentz provided an update on the 90th annual KSHSAA Coaching School scheduled for August 5-6, 2024. New for this year, the event will be held in Salina and will feature hands-on learning opportunities.

## **PROPOSED CHANGES TO PPE**

A new version of the KSHSAA Pre-Participation Physical Examination (PPE) form was presented following revision by members of the KSHSAA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee. The changes made to the document were based on concerns from stakeholders and the effort to embrace the best practices implemented in the last year. In addition, the SMAC recommended changes for the confidential handling of forms by schools. Following discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve the changes for implementation for the 2024-25 school year. The revised form will be posted online for access by schools and medical providers no later than the end of this month and in time for students completing new physicals starting May 1 for the following year. Information about document handling will be distributed to schools.

## **BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING – AGENDA REVIEW**

Following a preview of the KSHSAA Board of Directors April 25 meeting, the Executive Board approved a draft of the finalized agenda for the meeting. This included discussing items added to the agenda from other entities and finalizing agenda items discussed at previous meetings. The Board of Directors meeting will be held at the KSHSAA office building in Topeka and will begin at 3:00 p.m. on April 25, 2024.

## **KAY AND KAYAN INFORMATION**

Assistant Director Sarah Smith gave an overview of the mission and work of the KSHSAA singular program Kansas Association for Youth (KAY) in member schools and the support provided by KAYAN, the KAY Alumni Network. Discussion was held on the benefits of KAY for students and the partnerships across the state with the KAYAN.

## **SHOT CLOCK EXPERIMENT DISCUSSION**

Staff led discussion with the Executive Board relative to feedback received on the newly implemented shot clock experiment for 2024-25. Some of the feedback included resetting the clock after an offensive rebound and whether the home team or away team determine the use of a shot clock if it is available. Also discussed was if a tournament can allow for the use of a shot clock and who would determine those being used. Following a review of suggestions for implementation, the Board asked for a write-up of some information to add to the current language to be brought to their April meeting so they may discuss it with other member schools.

## **VIRTUAL STUDENT ELIGIBILITY**

The combination of current statute and the existing KSHSAA Virtual Student Eligibility policy establishes a different standard for students attending a virtual public school when compared to a virtual private school. Specifically, those attending a public virtual school are required to attend one in-person class to gain eligibility, while those attending a private virtual school are not required to attend any classes in person. Following discussion, the Executive Board modified the policy to eliminate the double standard by removing the sentence "The student must be currently enrolled and attending a minimum of one (1) class at the KSHSAA member public school where they desire eligibility."
