ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board heard reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reviewed fall activities which have been completed and gave a preview of winter activities where possible. The Executive Director gave a financial report and provided an overview of the annual report to the Kansas State Board of Education.

2022 FALL ADMINISTRATOR AND BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS

The Executive Director reported 128 middle/junior and 201 senior high schools were represented by 351 people who attended the seven KSHSAA Regional administrator and Board of Education Meetings. The attendance figures were as follows:

FALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

At the time of the meeting, seven of ten fall championships had been completed thanks to the hard work of the host sites, support staff, and administrative leaders for each activity. KSHSAA staff provided the Board members with a review and learning from each activity. Discussion focused on changes for future fall postseason events.

MEMBER MIDDLE SCHOOL REQUESTS LEAGUE AFFILIATION HEARING

Superintendent Renee Nugent, Principal Chad Bilderback and Athletic Director Tyler Lueckenhoff from Atchison Middle School, appeared before the Executive Board to request the Association assign their schools to a league per **Bylaw ARTICLE XV, League Affiliation**, which reads as follows:

Section 1: Any member school not a member of a league or similar organization may apply to the KSHSAA Executive Board for assistance in acquiring league affiliation.

Section 2: The Board of Directors of the KSHSAA shall develop procedures whereby: (1) the requesting school shall submit sufficient evidence to the Executive Board that it has made a conscientious effort to become affiliated with an existing league; (2) if it appears that the Executive Board may take affirmative action on the request, the requesting school and any league to which the school may be assigned shall have an opportunity to be heard by the Executive Board prior to the time the assignment is made; (3) the Executive Board, after considering all the facts in the matter, may assign the school to an existing league; (4) in the event a school is assigned to a league under the above-mentioned circumstances, no members shall withdraw from that league for a period of three years without unanimous consent of all members of the league including the newly-assigned school, or approval of the Executive Board.

Atchison Middle School has been unaffiliated with a league for more than 10 years. Information was presented to the Executive Board detailing unsuccessful efforts by the school to pursue league membership.

It was the decision of the Executive Board to grant a league assignment hearing at the next meeting of the Executive Board. Subsequently, that hearing has been scheduled for **Wednesday, January 11, 2023, at 3:00 p.m.** The Executive Board voted to have the members of the **Big 7 Jr. League and the Kaw Valley Jr. League** appear for the purposes of this hearing. It was noted, these leagues have similar sized schools in their membership and their member schools are in the approximate geographic area of Atchison Middle School. Superintendents, principals and athletic directors of all schools in the four identified leagues will receive a communication from Mr. Faflick inviting them to attend and participate in the January hearing.

GAMEDAY SHOWCASE

A report was given on final preparations for the Gameday Showcase which will be conducted on Friday, November 18 (Dance) and Saturday, November 19 (Cheer) at the Topeka Stormont Vail Events Center. Information on the schools participating was discussed as well as information on the partnership we continue to have with Varsity Spirit.

KSHSAA TRUEBLUE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM UPDATE

A draft of the KSHSAA Covered TrueBlue Scholarship program rubric was provided to Board members in anticipation for the 2022-23 school year award process. The program comes from the partnership between the KSHSAA and Capitol Federal and is a featured component of KSHSAA Covered. While looking at last year's applicant criteria list, feedback from Board members was provided on application criteria relating to financial need. The Board asked KSHSAA staff to work with partner Capitol Federal on redistributing other criteria grading percentages after eliminating this requirement.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At the request of the Executive Director, the Board entered an Executive Session to discuss matters related to non-elected personnel. Following this session, the Board approved part-time and temporary employment policies for inclusion in staff handbook information.

NAME IMAGE AND LIKENESS

At their November 2021 meeting, the Executive Board approved interpretations of **Amateur Rule 21** with regards to student opportunities relative to "Name, Image, and Likeness". The Board was given an opportunity to review this policy which reads:

A student may be compensated as an influencer or representative and/or provide an endorsement pending the following:

- *There shall be no interruption of the school day for the student.*
- *There shall be no reference to school name, school team, school logo, nor school mascot.*
- *Member school uniform may not be used by the student in any endorsement.*
- *Member school facilities may not be used in any student endorsement.*
- *Member school awards or awards won by students participating in activities shall not be referenced.*
- *No school practice film nor game film may be used in promotional activities.*
- *Neither endorsements nor promotions may be used to influence attendance at a member school.*
- *Students are not permitted to promote or endorse activities associated with the following: tobacco, alcohol, banned athletic substances, illegal substances or activities, or wagering.*

Member schools may have additional local policies as it pertains to their name, image, and/or likeness, so interpretations may continue to evolve over time. Board members provided feedback on the current policy and discussed instances the staff were made aware of throughout the first year of use. Staff were directed to continue to monitor and provide support for member schools with regards to NIL.

BASEBALL & SOFTBALL MANUAL UPDATES

Staff requested the Board consider an update for the 2022-23 baseball/softball manual relative to baseball pitch count reporting. The item under consideration would adopt the mandatory reporting of pitch counts using Game Changer. Currently schools have the option to use the KSHSAA website or Game Changer to report. Over 80% of teams use Game Changer to report and score the game. Assistant Director Jeremy Holaday discussed the two different tracking sites with the Board as well as the advantages for having one system. Following discussion, the Board approved the use of Game Changer exclusively for reporting baseball pitch counts and directed staff to include this mandate in the 2022-23 Baseball/Softball Manual.

FOOTBALL HOSTING FORMULA

Assistant Director Mark Lentz updated the Board on clarification requests he has received regarding football and the game hosting formula detailed in the Football Manual. Specifically, a school asked how to account for a bye which occurs in week 9 (the first game in the bracket). Following discussion, the Board confirmed staff should not count a bye game as a hosted game when formulating which team will host a playoff game. Additionally, the Board confirmed that Week 9 games should be included when considering the number of hosting opportunities. Staff were directed to create language for the Board to review in time to be included in the 2023 Football Manual.

OFFICIALS SERVICES POSITION REVIEW

The Board was given a proposed job description for the newly created Officials Services Director. Following a review and discussion, staff were directed to begin an employment search early in 2023 with their suggestion of hiring someone by early summer so they may have overlap time with outgoing Director, Francine Martin.

NASSP SANCTIONING TO CHANGE

The NASSP has provided communication indicating they will no longer be sanctioning events. Staff provided the Board with an overview of the implications and remedies being considered to overcome the elimination of this service. It is noted, the KSHSAA and member schools have used this service from the NASSP since its inception in the early 1970s as a means of finding debate, speech and other performing arts tournaments for students that are vetted and sanctioned. Board members discussed the possibility of a new organization taking over maintenance of the list. Staff was directed to continue monitoring the situation and to bring forth any changes in Handbook and/or Manual language by the January or March Executive Board meeting so updates can be passed along in a timely manner.

SCHOOL MASCOT DISCUSSION

On November 10, the Kansas State Board of Education accepted the Kansas Advisory Council for Indigenous Education Working Group's mascot reform statement and recommendations. The KSBE approved a strong recommendation to Kansas K-12 nontribal schools to adopt the actions recommended and retire Indian-themed mascots and branding as soon as possible, but no longer than within the next three to five years. State Board Member Deena Horst led discussion with the Executive Board on information coming from the KSBE recommendation and how the Association can support schools as they move forward.

ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION AND HANDBOOK LANGUAGE

Staff provided updates on a recent eligibility determination made on behalf of the Board. Following a review of this situation which resulted in the ineligibility of a student per *Rule 30 Seasons of Activities*, the Board was asked to provide input on this determination and the potential need for clarification via definitions to be included in the Handbook. Following discussion, the Board asked staff to draft language for Handbook consideration which will clarify the philosophical basis of Rule 30 and impact on student eligibility when a change of schools occurs. Draft language will be provided at upcoming Executive Board meetings to allow for amendment consideration at the spring 2023 Board of Directors meeting.

HONORING VETERANS

The Board was presented with information on an opportunity to provide complimentary admission to all veterans on a designated playoff football game. Following the example of neighboring states, staff members brought a policy forward to the Board that would allow for admission of a veteran military member plus one guest to any location, any classification, football game during the week celebrating national Veteran's Day. It was noted during the week of this celebration, the only activity participating in competitions is football. The Board unanimously voted to approve this practice starting in 2023 and directed staff to work with host schools to provide information on how this policy should be enacted and monitored.

ELIGIBILITY REVIEW

Following the transfer of their student, a request has been made by a parent for the Executive Board to reconsider the eligibility determination provided by staff congruent to **Rule 18, Transfer, Bona Fide Move**. Following presentations by the family and KSHSAA staff and a review of information regarding this transfer, the Board voted to uphold the determination of the KSHSAA staff and deny the eligibility of the student per the bona fide move definition in **Transfer Rule 18**.
