ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Executive Board heard reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The Executive Director provided a review of events and actions completed on behalf of the Board and Association since the previous meeting, including a financial report in conjunction with the financial services director. Administrative staff reviewed fall activities which have been completed and gave a preview of winter activities.

2025 REGIONAL MEETINGS

FALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

At the time of the meeting, seven of ten fall championships were completed thanks to the hard work of the host sites, support staff, and administrative leaders for each activity. KSHSAA staff provided the Board members with a review and learning from each activity. Discussion focused on lessons learned and possible adjustments for future fall postseason events.

POSTSEASON VOLLEYBALL FORMAT

Following a change in 2023, volleyball postseason seeding for Classes 6A and 5A includes the top 16 teams, with no play-in matches for teams ranked as numbers 17 and 18. In Class 4A, the play-in matches are still in place as they are for Classes 3A, 2A, 1A DI and 1A DII. For these smaller school classes, play-in matches are possible due to the size of the seeding pool and cooperative agreements, but for Class 4A teams, the play-in matches face hardships including the range in quality of play for specific regions. A recommendation came from staff to eliminate the play-in matches for Class 4A. Following discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve the recommendation.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At the request of the Executive Director, the Board entered an Executive Session on Wednesday, November 19 at 3:43 p.m. to discuss legal issues related to matters in which counsel has been engaged and for discussion on matters for non-elected personnel. Following the session, the Executive Board reconvened at 4:43 p.m.

HONORING VETERANS

An update was given to the Board following the third year of the KSHSAA providing complimentary admission to all active military veterans to football games played during the week of Veterans Day. Announcements were read at all games in appreciation of service members during the game and several sites had special ceremonies for veterans in attendance as part of the game night experience. The Board was given a chance to provide feedback to staff.

KSHSAA INFRASTRUCTURE MASTER PLANNING

Staff shared long-range plans to meet the eventual infrastructure needs of the KSHSAA building. An overview of upcoming projects and needed updates, as well as anticipated/estimated costs were provided. Board members were able to review resources available to meet these needs and discussion emphasized updating items in a timely matter.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR

Summary data from fall activities was provided to the Board on ejections occurring during fall activities. Per this information, as of November 10, there were 310 reported ejections from Kansas interscholastic activities. Discussion was held on the updated ejection/suspension policy and tools to develop in support of appropriate expectations for stakeholders. The Executive Board confirmed the effectiveness of the new policy and discussed fan behavior concerns.

OFFICIALS BACKGROUND CHECKS

Staff facilitated a preliminary discussion with the Executive Board relating to background checks for officials. A youth protection course was also discussed as a possible addition to official training. The Board directed staff to research options and create a proposal for the January meeting.

OFFICIALS POSTSEASON SELECTION PROCESS

Staff reviewed the postseason selection process for officials and requested feedback from the Board on the system. Discussion was held on the benefits of the area supervisor meetings, creating an observation component, official association presence across the state, crew vs individual recommendations, lack of accountability for regular season only officials and other ideas to increase the quality of officiating. Staff also shared concerns about postseason recommendations from schools who do not take the responsibility and opportunity to provide recommendations seriously, thus possibly compromising the integrity of the process.

BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENTS

At the September Executive Board meeting, staff recommended, and the Board approved a plan to consolidate all state softball championships to one location – consistent with expectations of the membership. At that time, baseball had not been finalized nor contracted. Following the meeting, based upon input and facility availability, the original plan was pulled back. Staff presented options for the Executive Board to consider for the 2026 baseball and softball postseason tournament format. Following extensive discussion, the Board voted 8 to 2 to approve the following option for the 2025-26 school year:

Quarterfinal round played at neutral sites***

May 25 – 4A, 3A, 2-1A Softball and Baseball

May 26 – 6A, 5A Baseball and Softball

4A, 3A, 2-1A Softball at Arrocha Ball Park - KU

May 27 – Semifinals for 4A, 3A

May 28 – Semifinals for 2-1A; Consolation for 4A, 3A

May 29 – Consolation for 2-1A; Championship for 2-1A, 3A and 4A

4A, 3A 2-1A Baseball at Hogle Stadium - KU

May 27 – Semifinals for 2-1A, 3A

May 28 – Semifinals for 4A; Consolation for 2-1A, 3A

May 29 – Consolation for 4A; Championship for 4A, 3A and 2-1A

6A & 5A Softball at Wilkins Stadium - Wichita State

May 28 - Semifinals for 6A and 5A

May 29 - Consolation for 6A and 5A; Championship for 6A and 5A

6A & 5A Baseball at Eck Stadium - Wichita State

May 28 - Semifinals for 6A and 5A

May 29 - Consolation for 6A and 5A; Championship for 6A and 5A

***Neutral sites are to be determined. The higher seeds in each tournament will earn the right to play as close to home as possible in relation to Association identified neutral sites. If the distance between the lower seed and the appropriate site is greater than 250 miles, the game will be played at a centrally located site of the neutral sites chosen. The sites will be analyzed and reviewed each year. The location of the games will be determined after regional play is concluded.

Game times and further details will be published in the KSHSAA Baseball and Softball manuals.

DOUBLE FIRST BASE FOR BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL

Starting in 2027, NFHS Rules will require all interscholastic baseball games to use a double first base. Discussion was held on information and direction from the National Federation and implementation in Kansas for both regular and postseason. Staff are awaiting final clarification from the NFHS regarding the base color as allowed by rule. Member schools are also reminded that a double first base will be used for all postseason softball games starting in this (2025-26) school year.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR MENTORING PROGRAM

In conjunction with the KIAAA, staff recommended the KSHSAA establish a mentoring program for new Athletic Administrators. The KSHSAA would provide stipends to retired athletic directors to serve as mentors for those in their first two years as a building AD. In order to be eligible, schools must agree to have the new AD attend the spring KIAAA Conference and meet regularly with their mentor. Mentors would meet in person no less than 4 times annually, with at least one in-person meeting each season of activity. Additionally, mentors would be in regular communication with their mentee/new AD. Up to six mentors would be hired to work in a geographically proximate manner and the KSHSAA will provide training and guidance for these mentors. Following discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve implementation of the program for the 2026-27 school year.

COACHES AND TESTS

At the September meeting, the Executive Board reviewed the success rate of coaches completing the required rules exam. Staff reviewed updated data for fall 2025 activities and compared coaching exam and rules meeting data to activity ejection data. Discussion was held on the next steps to encourage learning accountability for coaches. These steps included suspension from coaching following failure of rules tests and payment of fines to access additional testing. The Board directed staff to codify language and bring a proposal to their meeting in January for their approval.
