- **Officiating Fees** – Soccer, swimming & diving, track & field, and area supervisor officiating fees were reviewed and will remain unchanged for the next school year.
- **Middle/Jr. High At-Large Appointment** – Per **Bylaw Article IV, Section 5**, the Executive Board appointed Assistant Principal and Athletic Director Justin Briggs, Dodge City-Comanche Middle School, to a two-year at-large term on the Board of Directors (2010-2022).
- **Independent Schools Appointment** – Per **Bylaw Article IV, Section 4(e)**, the Executive Board appointed Principal David Schenk, Olathe Heritage Christian School, to a two-year term on the Board of Directors (2020-2022).

### PUBLIC FORUM

None present.

### ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

The Executive Board received reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick, and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reported on the culmination of winter activities and discussed the current status and plans surrounding KSHSAA activities affected by the Covid-19 Corona Virus. The Executive Director gave a financial report.

### LIABILITY AND CATASTROPHIC INSURANCE UPDATE

Jan Mason, Rebecca Shaffer, John Puetz, and Spencer Fields of Willis Towers Watson Insurance spoke with the Executive Board and provided an update on information pertaining to liability, catastrophic and medical coverage for member schools of the KSHSAA for the 2020-21 school year. It was voted unanimously to purchase coverage through Mutual of Omaha. Information regarding coverage and the premium per student will be mailed to all member school superintendents and principals in May with the annual membership mailing. There are no changes in coverage from last year (\$25K deductible, \$5M lifetime benefit). More specific information regarding coverage and benefits for the 2020-21 school year will be provided in the membership mailing. The premium per student will increase by 14 cents/participant (2.0%) for the next school year. Member schools will pay **\$6.97 to cover each student (grades 7 – 12) participating in KSHSAA athletic activities**, regardless of the number of activities in which the student participates.

### MEMBER SCHOOL DUES APPROVED FOR 2020–2021

The Executive Board voted unanimously to increase member school dues for the 2020-21 school year. The new membership dues will be \$500 senior high and \$200 middle/junior high school (formerly \$400 and \$125). KSHSAA membership materials will be mailed in May to building principals and superintendents of all member schools.

### BLUE VALLEY DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

Blue Valley USD 229 is implementing an early college program for students. The program provides 100% instruction on the college campus for both junior and senior years. Successful completion of the program results in a High School diploma and an Associate Degree. Blue Valley USD 229 administrators Lane Green (Director of School Administration) and Katie Bonnema (Director of Career-Ready Programs), participated in the discussion. Students participating in this Dual Degree program are not eligible for KSHSAA activities at Blue Valley schools as they are not attending at least one class in their base school as required by Rule 13 Scholarship Requirements (13-1-3(b)).

## PREPARTICIPATION PHYSICAL EXAM FORM UPDATED

The Executive Board Based reviewed the fifth monograph of the Pre-Participation Physical Exam which had been updated by the Sports Medicine Advisory Committee for use in Kansas schools. The Executive Board approved immediate adoption and implementation. It will be important to begin immediate education regarding updates including mental health information and privacy of student information. This form requires the doctor to sign in two places, and the parent to sign in three places. This includes a release for emergency treatment.

## QUASI-INDIVIDUAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS

The Executive Board has been requested to review a long-standing interpretation regarding schools entered into a cooperative agreement. The interpretation indicates schools participating in quasi-individual activities separate and represent respective schools in postseason competition. The request was to allow these schools to remain intact for postseason competition in the classification established by the combined enrollment of the schools in the cooperative agreement. Following discussion, the Executive Board maintained the existing interpretation which requires schools in cooperative agreements to separate for postseason competition in quasi-individual sports. Leagues maintain discretion regarding separation for their respective league championship competitions.

## PUBLIC – PRIVATE SCHOOL

Staff provided an update on initiatives and efforts to address the Public/Private school concern regarding a level playing field in the pursuit of championships. Topics to address included the timeline for distribution of a member school accountability tool, as well as the development and distribution of a survey for member schools.

## TRANSFER HARDSHIP DEFINITION

The Executive Board reviewed and approved the definition of a hardship as applied to transfer students. The board received and reviewed examples and non-examples of transfer hardships.

## TRANSFER RULE 18-1-4

Historically, students transferring from a non-member school are approved for immediate eligibility at the new school (assuming lack of undue influence and satisfaction of all other eligibility requirements). With implementation of the new transfer ineligibility period, the Executive Board recommended a modification to 18-1-4. This recommendation would allow non-varsity eligibility for students transferring from a non-member school for the first year of attendance in all activities. This item was referred to the May 1 Board of Directors for final approval.

## LISTEN/LEARN LEAGUE MEETING DISCUSSION

The Executive Board identified themes emerging from discussion and learning from meetings conducted with each Kansas High School League/Conference. While a few meetings are yet to be conducted, the common discussion threads thus far have included public/private issues, the need for more officials, and a continued emphasis on communication between the KSHSAA and member schools.

## 9TH GRADE FOOTBALL ISSUE

Based upon a request from a member school, the Executive Board discussed the possibility of allowing freshman football players to play “up” and play “down” during the regular season. This request would allow a school to have 9th grade students (freshman) from the high school practice/play at the Junior High/Middle School level due to a lack of students in the 7th and 8th grades while also allowing them to practice and participate in games at the high school level. Following discussion, it was determined by the Executive Board that schools should not be allowed to have students participate in both levels of practice/play. 9th grade students should either practice/play at the high school level or only at the Junior High level, but not both.

## SPIRIT GROUPS PARTICIPATING IN OUT OF STATE COMPETITIONS

The Executive Board reviewed current rules detailing the difference between school field trips for classes beyond the 500-mile limit as compared to athletic team trips. Precedent is based upon extension of **Rule 46 Music (46-1-4)** which has allowed these field trips for music classes. Discussion focused on the definition of what constitutes a class field trip versus a team trip. The Board approved the definition of a class and the protocol used to define a field trip. The Executive Board requested similar specific language be developed to modify rule **Rule 48 Spirit and Spirit Competition** to be placed the fall Board of Directors meeting.

## SPORTSMANSHIP

The Board received information regarding sportsmanship awards at the state basketball tournament prior to its cancellation and reviewed recent challenges experienced at member school games during the basketball season.

## VIRTUAL DEBATE

The Executive Board approved the opportunity for schools to participate in the NSDA virtual speech and debate championships during the summer of 2020. Participation is subject to this competition being NASSP approved, is for one year only, and is contingent upon all CDC and KDHE approved limits regarding COVID-19 being maintained. Qualification for this tournament will be via application, not by further competition.

## **BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEETING**

Following a preview of the agenda for the KSHSAA Board of Directors May 1 meeting, the Executive Board approved a draft of the finalized the agenda for the BOD meeting. The BOD meeting will be held in virtual format on applicable platform. The BOD meeting will begin at 3:00 p.m. on May 1, 2020.

The Executive Board held a special meeting at the request of the Executive Director, on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. with the following members participating: President Alan Stein, Shannon Haydock, Deena Horst, Mike Kastle, Penny Lane, Monty Marlin, Pam McComas, Roger Perkins, Matt Renk, Greg Rosenhagen, Ken Stonebraker, and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. Assistant Executive Directors Cheryl Gleason, Francine Martin, Mark Lentz, Jeremy Holaday, Craig Manteuffel, Rod Garman and Office/Operations Manager Brent Unruh also participated. Board member Mark Meyer was unable to participate.

### WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF MEETING REQUIREMENTS WAIVED

Motion was made and seconded to waive the required written notice for any meeting of the Executive Board as specified in KSH-SAA Bylaw Article V, Section 7. Motion passed 11-0.

### STATUS OF SPRING ACTIVITIES

The Executive Board received a briefing on the evolving status of COVID-19 and the potential impact on the spring sports and activities. Current guidance provided by the CDC, KDHE, and the KSDE was discussed. The Executive Order by Governor Kelly regarding the closure and cessation of in-person instruction in all Kansas schools through May 29 was discussed. A summary of the sentiment from correspondences provided by students, community patrons, and school leaders was discussed. The members of the Executive Board considered many options including suspension and extension of the spring season.
