The Executive Board of the Kansas State High School Activities Association met virtually via Zoom meeting platform on Wednesday and Thursday, November 18-19, 2020, with the following in attendance: President Alan Stein, Shannon Haydock, Jason Herman, Deena Horst, Mike Kastle, Monty Marlin, Roger Perkins, Greg Rosenhagen, Ken Stonebraker, and Bill Faflick, Executive Director. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board heard reports from Executive Director Bill Faflick and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reviewed fall activities which have been completed and gave a preview of winter activities where possible. The Executive Director gave a financial report and provided an overview of the annual report to the Kansas State Board of Education.

2020 FALL ADMINISTRATOR AND BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS

The Executive Director reported 135 middle/junior and 272 senior high schools were represented by 541 people who attended the seven KSHSAA Regional Administrator and Board of Education Meetings. The attendance figures were as follows:

BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO MEET FOR SPECIAL MEETING

The Executive Board reviewed current data regarding COVID-19. Information was presented from various sources including a Wisconsin study of high school activities, data on Kansas incident numbers since May, and a survey from a Greenbush forum of about 90 Kansas superintendents. The KSHSAA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee also provided a recommendation to the Executive Board and a discussion was held on the increased numbers of coronavirus infection rates in Kansas.

Following the data presentation, staff requested the Executive Board approve a request to call a Board of Directors meeting in order to modify rules for winter season sports and activities. The reason to modify rules is to help mitigate the possible spread of the Covid-19 coronavirus. Following discussion, the Executive Board voted to send the proposed winter season changes to the Board of Directors for a final vote.

The special session of the Board of Directors will be held virtually on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 in order to discuss and decide on the extended moratorium period and other proposed winter activity modifications.

FALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

At the time of the meeting, six of seven fall sport championships had been completed thanks to the hard work of the host sites, support staff, and administrative leaders for each activity. KSHSAA staff provided the Board members with a review and learning from each activity.

WINTER POSTSEASON PROTOCOL

Staff presented the Board with expectations for number of qualifying teams, protocols for seeding, and other efforts to make these winter postseason events appropriately significant considering the effects of the Covid-19 coronavirus.

Basketball – The Executive Board received postseason recommendations per support material with modifications including geographic seeding for preliminary rounds, quarterfinals at the higher seed on Monday/Tuesday of championship week, four teams advancing to neutral state site, and the elimination of the third-place games (both semifinal losers receive third place plaque and medals).

Bowling – The Executive Board received postseason bowling recommendations per support material with modifications including increased number and pod format for regional competition and appropriate considerations for the state bowling tournaments.

Scholars Bowl – The Executive Board received postseason recommendations per support material with modifications including refined qualifying tournament protocol which increases the number of regional tournaments, adjusts dates for identified classifications, and appropriate considerations for the state scholars bowl competition.

Swimming & Diving – The Executive Board received postseason recommendations per support material with modifications to allow for one day per classification state meet with timed finals in swimming events and possible limited number of entries.

Wrestling – The Executive Board received postseason recommendations per support material with revised regional and state competition formats as provided in the support material which includes additional qualifying rounds and a change in postseason calendar. In all rounds, top four advance to subsequent tournament.

PUBLIC-PRIVATE WORK GROUP FORMED

Staff provided the Executive Board with a brief look at the recent history of discussions concerning public and private schools across the state. Staff provided a list of possible candidates to serve on a work group to detail the specifics of refining classification rules to include a defined multiplier for private schools. It is expected the work group will schedule two meetings, one via zoom to provide an overview, share existing materials, and to discern what other materials would be helpful for workday. The second meeting will be a full day work session to develop a proposal to present to the Board of Directors. The proposed roster of attendees is as follows:

Following discussion, the Executive Board approved the creation of the work group and instructed Mr. Faflick to contact the proposed members.

GAMEDAY SHOWCASE

A report was given on final preparations for the Gameday Showcase awards ceremony, which will be conducted in a virtual format with a "live" award show via virtual platform for each division of dance and each classification of cheer, both on November 21. Information on the schools participating as well as links to the awards ceremony can be found on the main KSHSAA website (www.kshsaa.org).

PRESEASON BOWLING INSTRUCTION APPROVED

The Executive Board approved an opportunity for bowling coaches to provide classroom instruction for members of their team following team try-outs and prior to the first day of practice (January 1). This optional education opportunity may not exceed 5 hours. The 5 hours must take place within one calendar week. No session may last longer than 2 hours.

SPRING MUSIC FESTIVALS

A committee has been working diligently to provide a virtual music festival for member schools and their students this spring. The KSHSAA is investing in revisions to the existing Festival Program to facilitate a one-year suspension of the traditional regulations for these festivals. The major changes include a reduction in the length of program, the level of difficulty of performance, and the ability to have comments for all performances and ratings upon request. The Executive Board approved this protocol and empowered administration to make final decisions within defined parameters.

VIRTUAL SPEECH COMPETITIONS/FESTIVALS

Mr. Manteuffel and a committee of speech coaches are in the process of developing a virtual format for spring competitions and festivals. It is anticipated the final product will be similar to the virtual format being used for 2020-21 postseason debate. The Executive Board provided general approval for the virtual format with the specific details to be finalized by the staff working in collaboration with the KSCA.

SCHOOL DEBATE TEAM REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL COMPETITION DENIED

The Topeka-Hayden High School requested staff grant a hardship approval of an additional debate event for their students per KSHSAA Handbook *Rule 47 Debate and Speech, Section 2, Article 2 (Note)* on the basis their tournament could not be held in person due to Covid-19. Historically, schools afforded the exception to the hosting expectation in the rule are granted the additional meet when their efforts to host are thwarted due to weather and/or unanticipated travel issues. The initial determination provided by staff denied the additional competition for Hayden as all schools have addressed hardship of funding and technology encountered in the virtual format allowed this season and all schools need events to attend to provide opportunities for their respective students. Following discussion, the Executive Board voted to uphold the original determination to deny the additional debate event exception to Hayden High School.

POSTSEASON OFFICIALS TRAVEL MODIFIED

Based upon the implementation of the new zone protocol for officials working regional and substate games, it was necessary to modify travel allocations. The revised pay rates for travel were reviewed and approved by the Executive Board.

POSTSEASON DEBATE CONSENT FORM CREATED

Staff reviewed with the Board guidance on virtual events from the National Federation (NFHS). Specifically discussed was postseason debate and speech events and the possibility for less supervision at virtual events. The NFHS provided a model consent form which staff updated to specific Kansas requirements and asked legal counsel to review. Following discussion, the Executive Board approved adoption of the consent form requirement for all postseason debate (2-speaker, 4-speaker) and speech participants prior to participation in regional competition. The document will be distributed by schools and the executed form returned to the KSHSAA who will retain it.

SUBSTATE VOLLEYBALL AWARDS CLARIFICATION

Based upon a member school league communication, staff reviewed protocol for awarding plaques in postseason volleyball competitions. In summary, if 8 teams or more are scheduled in round of competition, winner and runner up recognition is provided. Events with fewer than 8 will only award a championship plaque.

REMOTE LEARNING VIA DIRECT INSTRUCTION POLICY EXTENDED

Originally, the Remote Learning via Direct Instruction policy was created and approved for first semester of this 2020-21 school year. Following discussion, the Executive Board approved an extension of this policy for second semester of 2020-21 school year.

MUSIC RULE PROPOSAL FOR SPECIAL BOD MEETING

The Executive Board approved a one-year modification of Handbook Rule 46-2-1 Music to provide for one postseason event (state) if the music festivals are offered in virtual format. This proposed modification will be placed on the agenda for the special Board of Directors meeting.
