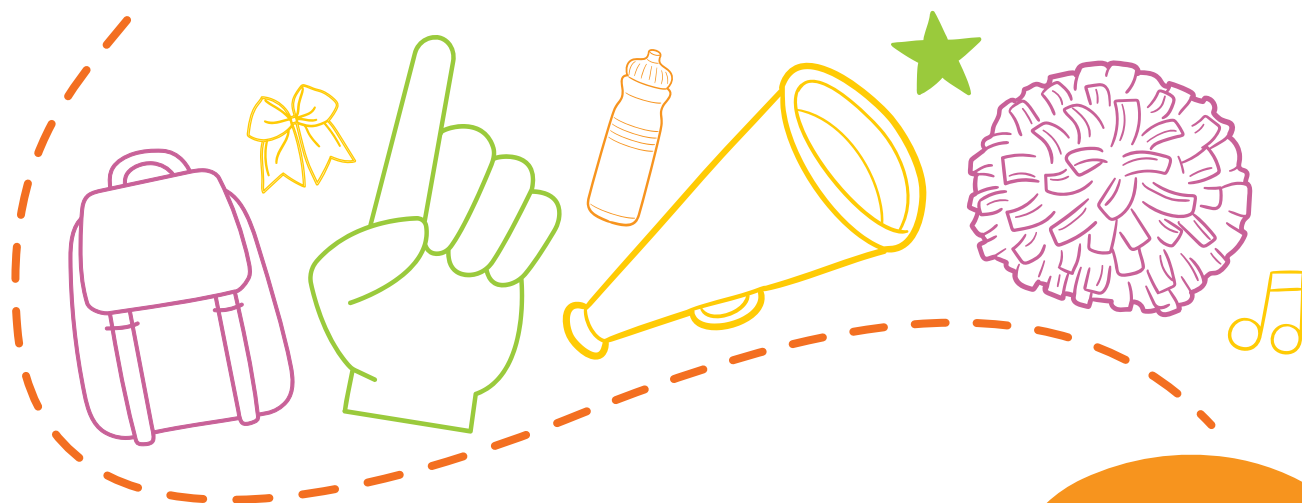

All KSHSAA 2025 Summer Dance Camps will have a "Game Day" learning emphasis to educate coaches on the specifics of "Game Day".

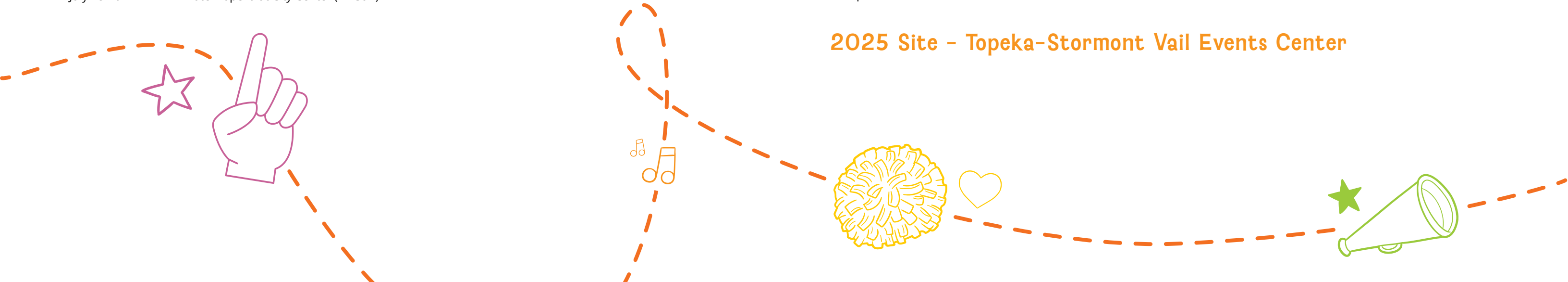

application forms

Application forms are available behind the school login on the KSHSAA website under Activities>Spirit. See your Athletic Director for School ID and coach's password if you don't know it. Email the appropriate form (Summer Cheer or Dance Camp Application Form) to kwilhelm@kshsaa.org on or before **May 1**. Some camp spots may fill before May 1. We will take registrations after May 1 if there are still spots available in a camp.

fees

College Site Camps - The overnight registration fee is **\$340** per person. The fee includes accident/sickness insurance, housing, 9 meals, conference materials, and quality **UCA/UDA** instructors.

We also offer a commuter camp option for schools who are in close proximity. The commuter registration fee is **\$270** per person. The commuter fee includes accident/sickness insurance, conference materials, and quality **UCA/UDA** instruction. **No meals or lodging is included in the commuter camp fee.**

Hotel Topeka at City Center Camp – Pricing is per person, per room. **The commuter option is not available for the Hotel Topeka at City Center camp.**

4 people = \$345 each

3 people = \$370 each

2 people = \$420 each

1 person = \$595

We offer a special fee reduction for **ONE** adult coach/sponsor. **Discounted coach fees do not apply for the Hotel Topeka at City Center camp.**

0-9 students – full tuition charged

10-19 students – ½ tuition charged

20+ students – no tuition charged

payments/roster of delegates forms

School athletic directors will be invoiced for the camp total once the Summer Cheer or Dance Camp Roster of Delegates form is received. These forms are also available behind the school login on the KSHSAA website under Activities>Spirit. Please email completed Roster of Delegates forms to kwilhelm@kshsaa.org. We would like to have this form by May 1 so schools can get invoiced before breaking for the summer. Our preference is to receive full payment at least two weeks before the start of your camp.

Detailed information will be mailed to coaches regarding registration, daily schedule, health cards and campus information in early/mid-May after Roster of Delegates forms are received.
