Hummer Sports Park and Game Information:

- <u>Ticket Information</u>: Tickets can be purchased prior online at GoFan <u>or</u> purchased with cash at ticket booths. Visit the GoFan App, the GoFan website or the KSHSAA website <u>https://gofan.co/app/school/KSHSAA</u>. Tickets on your device will be validated at the gate as you enter the facility.
- <u>KSHSAA Ticket Prices</u>: \$10 Adult and Student (K-12). NO PASSES ACCEPTED
 Three Ticket Booths open at 11:00 AM and are located on the west, southeast & northeast side of the football stadium.
- <u>Pass Gate/Officials Entrance</u>: (Soccer Stadium) 436 SW Oakley Drive North end of the soccer parking lot through the double gates. Please make sure your pass lists is submitted online to KSHSAA. Only individuals identified on your Squad Lists/ KSHSAA Pass Gate Form will be admitted free of charge. Field Passes must be worn at all times to be allowed on the field.
- <u>Team Unloading/Loading Location</u>: (Soccer Stadium) **436 SW Oakley Drive** Both teams will drop off and pick up on the west side of the soccer stadium on the north end of the parking lot. All team personnel must go through the pass gate.
- <u>Bands & Cheer Squads Unloading/Loading Location</u>: (Soccer Stadium) 436 SW Oakley Dr. Must enter thru pass gate located on the west side of the soccer stadium. Free admission allowed for ONLY 50 band and 10 cheer members in uniform. Any additional members over the allotment must purchase a \$10 ticket individually or per school by cash or check.
- <u>Bus Parking</u>: (Cap Fed Natatorium) **530 SW Tuffy Kellogg Drive** All buses need to park in the parking lot located at the Capital Federal Natatorium. Drivers will be shuttled back to the Sports Park.

- <u>Full Concessions</u> are available on both sides of the stadium : CASH ONLY
- <u>Certified Athletic Trainer</u>: AED and athletic training room will be available onsite, provided by KU Health Systems. Team must provide tape and supplies. AMR will be onsite.
- <u>National Anthem</u> played at 12:55 PM (5 min. on game clock)
- <u>Halftime</u>: Halftime will be 15 minutes without performances and will be 20 minutes with dance/band performances as well as a 3-minute warm-up period.
- <u>Postgame Presentation Ceremony</u> (See pg. 30 KSHSAA Football Manual) immediately following game No spectators are allowed on the playing field during award ceremony. Spectators are permitted on the field after ceremony, but not until then.
- <u>Media credentials or Requests</u> must be email to (dashmore@tps501.org) or contact the Hummer Sports Park 785-295-3750 with any questions prior to Nov 22. Filming will be on the landing outside of the press box.
- <u>Hummer Sports Park Facility Restrictions</u>: <u>NO</u> Outside Food, Drinks, Coolers, Drones, Dogs, Vaping, Smoking, Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco, Firearms and Artificial Noisemakers on Topeka Public Schools Property. Thank you for teams and fans adhering to these restrictions.
