Congratulations on earning a trip to the KSHSAA 8-Player State Football Championship Game. The Newton Recreation Commission and USD #373 are proud to host this eventful game and look forward to having all of you as our guests in Newton.

I am enclosing some items of interest, along with a schedule for the day.

- 1. Wichita County is the home team and will be on the north sideline (press box side) of the stadium and will use the west locker room. Wichita County will dress before the game at the Newton High School. Little River is the visiting team and will be on the south sideline and will use the east locker room. Little River will also dress before the game at Newton High School. We will have a team host greet each team at the high school and then escort each team to Fischer Field. The locker rooms at Fischer Field will become available as soon as the teams from the first game vacate their locker room. The field will be open to teams for pre-game warm-ups at 2:00 p.m.
- 2. Game Time is 3:30 p.m.
- 3. Normal 15-minute halftime. No halftime performances.
- 4. National Anthem will be played by the Wichita County Band.
- 5. The pass gate will be located on the west side entrance of the stadium.
- 6. Tickets will go on sale beginning at 9:00 a.m. and gates will also open at 9:00 a.m. Tickets may also be purchased online through the KSHSAA web site.
