Dear Scholars Bowl Coach and Team,

On behalf of KSHSAA and its 1A Division II member schools, I would like to congratulate you on your qualification for the 2020 KSHSAA 1A Division II State Scholars Bowl Championships. The State tournament will be held on Saturday, February 13, 2021 at Chase High School. The tournament will start at noon, with registration and lunch starting at 11am.

When you arrive at Chase High School, please park in the spaces along the school on Ave C and enter the building through the main doors. You will check in at the front door, have temperatures taken, and then directed to our Old Gym, where teams will be seated in pre-arranged locations. We will be providing a light meal (*sandwich, cookie, chips, drink*) to all participants, coaches and drivers from 11:00-11:30. There will not be a concession stand, feel free to bring in snacks. Lunch will be served to teams in the Old Gym. If you or any of your students need a vegetarian option, please let me know by Monday, February 8th. If you let me know after that date, I cannot ensure that one will be available.

The tournament will be round-robin format with teams competing in one pool of eight as determined by the KSHSAA. The top four teams will advance to the finals, which will also be in a bracket, where they will compete to be 1A State Champions. The champion, runner-up, etc. will then be determined based on standard KSHSAA tie-breaker rules. We will be using the questions provided by KSHSAA in this tournament. Trophies will be presented to the top three teams, and medals to the top four. This will be done in our auditorium following the competition.

Please remember to submit your State Scholars Bowl Tournament (SB-2) form to me either through email or by faxing it by Tuesday, February 9th and mail your state entry form (SB-3) as well as \$100 entry fee to KSHSAA by Tuesday, February 9th. If you have a preferred email other than what is on the KSHSAA website, please let me know. Also, if you would please remember to bring a working set of buzzers, that would be greatly appreciated (though we hope to make arrangements).

In the event of inclement weather, contact will be made regarding a new date. The decision to postpone would not be made until we consult with KSHSAA and Mr. Rod Garman. If there is a decision to postpone the event, we will let you know about the postponement and about new arrangements as soon as we possibly can.
