 Championships on Saturday, May 28th start times Noon and 2 pm

- **Soccer Stadium Team Drop Off and Fan Parking Location: 436 SW Oakley Drive, Topeka, KS**
- **Bus Parking Lot (6th and Tuffy Kellogg)** located at football parking lot on east side of Sports Park.
- **Pass Gate/ Officials Entrance: (436 SW Oakley Drive)** North end of the soccer parking lot through the double gates. **Only individuals identified on your Squad Lists/ KSHSAA Pass Gate Form will be admitted free of charge.**
- **Locker Room Assignment and Key** will be given to head coach at pass gate. **Teams will remain in the same locker room both days. DO NOT** leave any valuables or equipment in the locker rooms at any time. Place key in drop box inside of locker room by the door at the conclusion of tournament.
- **Tickets must be purchased online only at GoFan or KSHSAA website (purchase prior to arriving)** To do so, visit the GoFan App, the GoFan website <https://gofan.co/app/school/KSHSAA> , or the KSHSAA website <https://www.kshsaa.org/public/soccer/stategirls.cfm> . Then, when you arrive to the ticket gate, simply show your GoFan ticket on your device, and it will be validated. GoFan Ticketing spectators may purchase digital tickets for both days. There is a minimal convenience/processing fee for digital tickets.
- **KSHSAA Ticket Prices: \$9 Adult and \$6 Student (K-12) NO PASSES or CASH ACCEPTED**
- **Full Concessions Available : CASH ONLY**
- **Certified Athletic Trainer**, AED and athletic training room will be available onsite, provided by KU Health Systems. Team must provide tape and supplies. Ambulance service is available upon request.
- **Media credentials or requests** must be email to (dashmore@tps501.org) or contact the Hummer Sports Park Office 785-295-3750 with any questions by 3pm May 26th. Filming will be on the landing outside of the press box.
- **Hummer Sports Park Facility Restrictions:** NO Outside Food or Drinks, Drones, Pets, Vaping, Smoking, Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Artificial Noisemakers allowed on TPS 501 property including the parking lots. Thank you for teams and fans adhering to these restrictions.
- **Award Ceremonies** will occur immediately at the conclusion of each championship game.

Team Warm-ups

Participation schools will NOT be allowed to practice at the tournament site prior to the start of the tournament. We will start the clock 90 minutes before the first game on both days. Teams may take the field 50 minutes prior to the start of the first contest that day. Fifty minutes will be placed on the clock for team warm-ups and run down to the 10 minute mark, at which time teams will prepare for introductions and the National Anthem.

Prior to the second game of the day, 30 minutes will be placed on the clock for team warm-up and run down to the 10-minute mark before lining up for introductions.

Teams are responsible to bring their own warm-up balls and may use the football field prior to start of second game for warm-ups.
