## Locker Rooms

## Pass Gate

## Team/Bus Drop-Off and Parking

If you are traveling by bus, drop off the team at the main entrance of the Indoor Practice Facility (see map below) and park on the west side of the Indoor Practice Facility. If you are traveling by van, you can also park in this same parking lot.

## Tickets:

### Daily Admission Pricing (set by KSHSAA):

- \$10 (K-Adult; children under kindergarten are free)
- *No passes accepted.*
- *Only card transactions will be accepted on site for ticket and merchandise purposes.*
- ***No cash accepted. We encourage spectators to use GoFan to purchase tickets prior to arriving to avoid lines.***

## GoFan Ticketing

Spectators may purchase digital tickets for both days. To do so, visit the GoFan App, the GoFan website <https://gofan.co/app/school/KSHSAA>, or the KSHSAA website <https://www.kshsaa.org/Public/Soccer/StateBoys.cfm>.

Then, when you arrive at the ticket gate, simply show your GoFan ticket on your device, and it will be validated. There is a minimal convenience/processing fee for digital tickets.



## Warm-Ups

Participating schools will NOT be allowed to practice at the tournament site prior to the start of the tournament. We will start the clock with 90 minutes before the first game on both days. Teams may take the field 50 minutes prior to the start of the first contest that day. Fifty minutes will be placed on the clock for team warm-up and run down to the 10-minute mark. At that point, teams are to prepare for introductions and the National Anthem.

Prior to the second game of the day, 30 minutes will be placed on the clock for team warm-up and run down to the 10-minute mark before lining up for introductions.

Teams are responsible to bring their own warm-up balls.

The full-size indoor field will be available for warm-ups prior to the Friday, 7 p.m. game, and Saturday's Championship game.
